Stay Seated: Remaining seated prevents injuries and allows the driver a clear view to the rear.

Maintain a Calm Environment: Keep noise levels inside the bus low to minimize distractions for the driver and others.

Avoid Throwing Debris: To prevent stumbling and slipping hazards, don't throw things on the floor.

Bus Conduct Expectations: Follow bus driver instructions, including keeping your hands to yourself, respecting everyone, and no bullying.

Use Seat Belts: Although not required, consider using seat belts for added safety during the ride.

Food Items: No eating or drinking on the bus.

Window Usage: Do not open windows without the driver's permission and never put your arms or head out.

Safe Exiting: When getting off at your stop, exit promptly, make eye contact with the bus driver, and cross in front of the bus at least ten feet away.

Emergency Equipment Awareness: Familiarize yourself with the location of emergency equipment like emergency doors and first aid kits. Ask the bus driver if assistance is needed.

Stranger Safety: Never speak to strangers or accept rides from them.
