- K-8 registration deadline is 11/15/23, High School 11/30/23 for High School. Intramural registrations are accepted on a first come, first serve basis subject to capacity restrictions. Late fees apply after deadlines.

League Structure: These grade level structures are subject to change

- Coed grades K-1, weekly 60-minute group instructional session. Basketball and t-shirt included.
- Coed grades 2-3 consists of 10 games (1 game & practice/week)
- Boy's program, grades 4-12, consists of 10 games + playoffs (1 game & practice/week)
- Girl's program, grades 4-8, consists of 10 games + playoffs (1 game & practice/week)
- Games are typically played on Saturdays for grades K through 5 and weeknights for grades 6 and up.
- Intramural league begins in December and ends in mid-March.
