<p>DUE NOVEMBER 15</p>	<p>MINORITY/WOMEN IN STEM SCHOLARSHIP - 5 AWARDS OF \$500</p> <p>This scholarship aims to support underprivileged students who are interested in pursuing careers in STEM. <p>DUE NOVEMBER 15</p>	<p>MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,000-\$7,500/YEAR</p> <p>The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2024 competition. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university.</p>
<p>DUE NOVEMBER 15</p>	<p>MIZZOU GENERAL AND DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIPS</p> <p>If you are planning on attending Mizzou, apply by Nov. 15th. You aren't automatically considered for every scholarship at Mizzou. To be considered for general and departmental scholarships from Mizzou, log into ScholarshipUniverse to answer a series of matching questions. <p>DUE NOVEMBER 15</p>	<p>JACK KENT COOKE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP</p> <p>This is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend and graduate from the nation's best four-year colleges and universities. Each award is intended to cover a significant share of the student's educational experience.
