The vision of Northwest ISD fine arts is to be the premier school district in the state of Texas for the visual and performing arts.



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
- Northwest ISD is committed to providing every student with the highest level of instruction in the visual and performing arts.

Visual/Performing Arts Enrollment










Students Currently Enrolled in One or More Fine Arts Class Grades 6-12 77% of Secondary Student Population




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Highlights of Program Accomplishments

- Northwest ISD is regularly named a Best Community for Music Education
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- Northwest ISD was named a Texas Art Educators Association District of Distinction
- Students from all seven Northwest ISD middle schools were involved in the annual Middle School Musical performance, *Little Mermaid, Jr.*
- District fine arts programs received more than \$600,000 in grants in ten-year span
- More than 350 students selected to band, choir or orchestra all-region process
- Fourteen art students advanced to TAEA State VASE event
- Twelve students were selected to the TMEA All-State music ensembles
- All high school fine arts programs performed school-wide Broadway musicals
- The Dazzlers, Sapphires and Sidekicks dance teams each performed in a state or national competition, earning top marks including two Grand Championships
- Northwest High School JV Drill Team won Grand Champions at Showtime International
- Byron Nelson, Eaton and Northwest bands earned Division 1 ratings from all judges at UIL Region 2 Marching Band Contest
- District middle school One Act Play festival







Highlights of Program Accomplishments Continued

- Five fine arts groups (choir, band, orchestra, etc.) were National Winners or Commended Winners in The Foundation for Music Education's Mark of Excellence contests
- Northwest ISD Middle School Dance Team performed a district-wide showcase
- All 10 Northwest ISD middle and high school bands combined to perform at the annual Northwest ISD Band Showcase at NISD Stadium
- Students and squads from across the district also came together for the NISD Cheer Showcase, NISD Dance Showcase, as well as NISD band and orchestra concerts
- Multiple musical theatre programs and students were nominated at the Broadway Dallas and Betty Buckley Awards
- Byron Nelson High School placed second, and Eaton High School placed third in the UIL Spirit State Championships for cheerleading
- Steele Early College High School competed in UIL One Act Play for the first time in school history
- *Permanent Flux*, a student rock band at Steele Early College High School, performed at numerous school events
