**Change Orders to the GMP (Guaranteed Maximum Price) Contracts for the New Buildings**

**11-121-19** On a motion by Mrs. Kuhn, seconded by Mrs. Rugless to approve the recommended change orders to the GMP (Guaranteed Maximum Price) contracts for the new buildings as follows:

**K-6 CD-0009 Alternate #18B - Intrusion Detection = \$62,846.99**

Owner requested this change order. Funded from Skanska-Megen construction manager's hard contingency return to Owner at the 25% progress mark – they returned 10% of their contingency so far.

**K-6 CD-0015 Electrical 75% to 100% = \$81,046.72**

Difference in construction costs for building electrical systems between 75% Construction Documents (CD's) completed and Final 100% CD's completed. The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) is set at 75% construction documents, blueprints and drawings completed with the design intent narrative and the contract allows for reasonable adjustments to account for this difference based on unforeseen code requirements, commissioning comments, drawing interpretations, field conditions and/or constructability findings.

**K-6 CD-0028 Structural 75% to 100% = \$117,271.32**

Difference in construction costs for structural steel between 75% Construction Documents (CD's) completed and Final 100% CD's completed. The Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) is set at 75% construction documents, blueprints and drawings completed with the design intent narrative and the contract allows for reasonable adjustments to account for this difference based on unforeseen code requirements, commissioning comments, drawing interpretations, field conditions and/or constructability findings.

**K-6 CD-0027 Fire Pump = \$52,763.21**

This piece of equipment was value engineered out of the project right before GMP to help the budget. As construction began, field conditions and actual calculations were conducted, it became necessary in working with local code officials to again include it in the project for safety purposes.

**7-12 CD-0029 Alternate #18D – Intrusion Detection = \$65,609.69**

Owner requested this change order. Funded from Skanska-Megen construction manager's hard contingency return to Owner at the 25% progress mark – they returned 10% of their contingency so far.

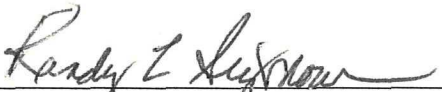

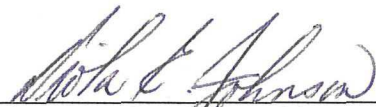

**Functions:**

**Instruction (1100 – 1200):** Instruction includes the activities directly dealing with the teaching of pupils or the interaction

between teacher and pupil. Teaching may be provided for pupils in a school, in a classroom, in another location, such as in a home or hospital, and through other approved media such as television, radio, telephone and correspondence.

**Pupils (2100):** Activities which are designed to assess and improve the well-being of pupils and to supplement the teaching process. e.g., Pupil personnel, guidance, health, psychological, speech and audiology, attendance, graduation and student assembly services.

**Instructional Staff (2200):** Activities associated with assisting the instructional staff with the content and process of providing learning experiences for pupils. e.g., Curriculum development, staff training, ed. aides and media services.

**Board of Education (2300):** Activities concerned with establishing policy in connection with operating the District.

**School Administration (2400):** Activities concerned with administrative responsibility e.g., Supt. & Principal offices.

**Fiscal (2500):** Activities associated with the financial operations of the District. e.g., Treasurer's office.

**Business (2600):** Activities concerned with directing & managing service areas. e.g., Business Manager's office.

**Operation of Plant (2700):** Activities concerned with keeping the physical plant open, comfortable and safe for use and keeping buildings and equipment in an efficient working condition. e.g., Maintenance & custodial areas.

**Transportation (2800):** Activities concerned with the conveyance of students to and from school and to activities.

**Statistical Services (2900):** Activities, other than general administration, which support each of the other instructional and supporting services programs. e.g., Personnel and technology.

**Community Services (3200):** Payments made by the District to support activities that do not directly relate to providing education for pupils in the District.

**Extracurricular Activities (4000):** Subject matter and/or activities not provided in regular classes. Generally, participation is not required and credit is not given.

**Capital Outlay (5000):** Improvements to the District buildings & land.

**Contingencies (7000):** To be used for unanticipated emergencies.

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-120-19**

**RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED TO LEVY AN  
ADDITIONAL TAX FOR CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES IN  
EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of Winton Woods City School District (the "Board of Education") has heretofore declared the necessity of levying an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Winton Woods City School District (the "School District") pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Ohio Revised Code for the purpose of current operating expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Board of Education has heretofore certified to the County Auditor a Resolution requesting the County Auditor to certify to this Board of Education the total current tax valuation of this School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by six and ninety-five hundredths (6.95) mills per year as specified in such Resolution, and this Board of Education has received the certification of the County Auditor that such total current tax valuation is \$459,573,200 and that such dollar amount of revenue is \$3,194,034 per year;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of the Winton Woods City School District, County of Hamilton, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That it is hereby declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised in this School District within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of this School District.

**SECTION 2.** That pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of such ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current operating expenses, at the rate not exceeding six and ninety-five hundredths (6.95) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to sixty-nine and five tenths cents (\$0.695) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a continuing period of time.



**SECTION 3.** That the question of the adoption of said tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the School District at the election to be held on March 17, 2020, and if said levy is approved by a majority of said electors, such additional tax shall first be placed upon the 2020 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2021.

**SECTION 4.** That the form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows (which ballot language may be modified, as appropriate, by the applicable Board of Elections or the Secretary of State of Ohio):

**SECTION 6.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Education concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board of Education; and that all deliberations of this Board of Education and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

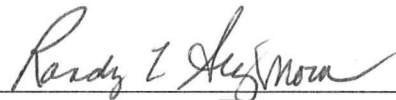
