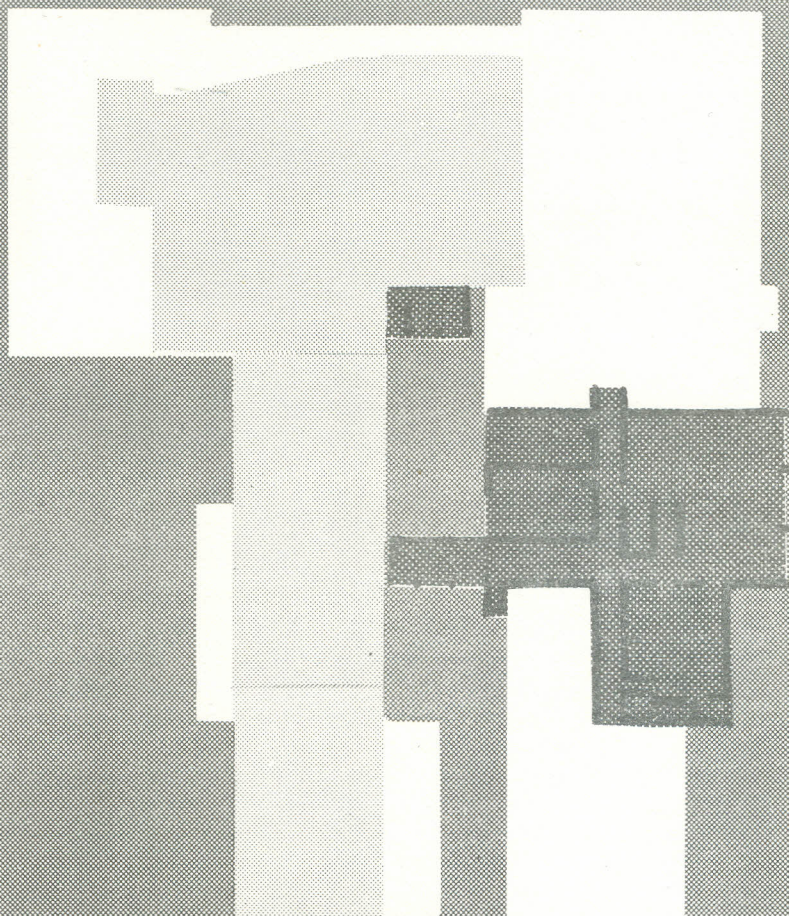

## ABOUT THE BUILDING

This addition to Revere High School is but one of several planned phases to be constructed as the student population of Bath-Richfield continues to grow. The cover design indicates the older section of the high school lightly shaded, the newly completed addition in black, and projected additions in white. Included in future building plans are an area for music classes, a new gymnasium and locker facilities, an industrial arts wing, and additional classrooms.

### Information About the Addition

Building Occupied ----- September 7, 1964

New Facilities: Cafeteria, kitchen, library, four classrooms,  
addition to boiler room, bridge

Remodeled Classrooms: The old library was converted into a classroom, a reading laboratory, and an office. The cafeteria and kitchen were remodeled into two classrooms, a mathematics laboratory and an office. A physics laboratory has been provided by remodeling an older classroom.

Other Changes: An additional water well at the high school,  
plus piping, enlarged heating plant for the school
