He played for the Rams for 9 years, including winning Super Bowl XXXIV. In 2008, Andy played his last year with the Detroit Lions and then he retired. 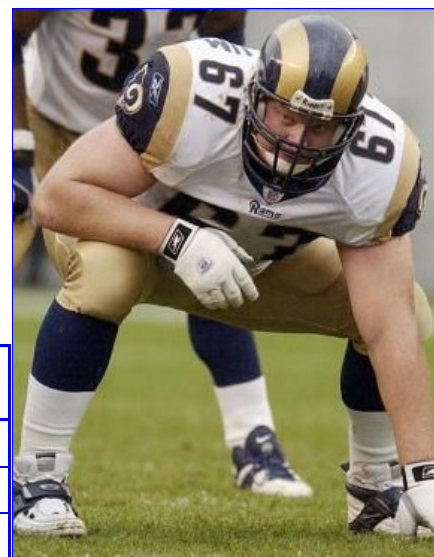
