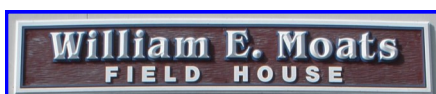

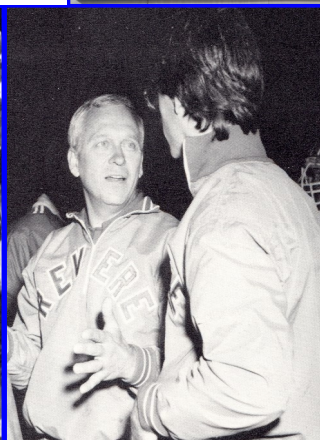
What do you miss most about RHS?: "A teacher—Evelyn Bruner"
