# History of Revere Local School District

## Region

The Connecticut Western Reserve was land claimed by Connecticut in the Northwest Territory in what is now northeastern Ohio. Early settlers called the territory "New Connecticut," but that name was later discarded in favor of "Western Reserve." In 1796, Connecticut sold that land to investors, eight investors from Suffield, Connecticut. These investors formed the Connecticut Land Company which then surveyed the land as well as encourage settlement.

## Richfield

**Township**—In 1809 Lancelot Mays came to this area with his wife and built a log cabin on the property at 3600 & 3636 Broadview Road. The land belonged to Herman Oviatt who had purchased it from the Connecticut Land Company. In April of 1816, by the authority of the Commissioners of Portage County (to which Richfield belonged at the time) Richfield became its own township. The way it received its name has two versions: 1) it was given name Richfield due to the fertile soil that the area contained; 2) it was given the name Richfield due to the large amount of "Oxbalm" or "rich feed" available to feed cattle.

**Schools**—In 1816 Richfield Township built a building that served as town hall, church, court, social hall, and school house. Leamon Farnham, son of early settler John Farnhm, was the first teacher. In the coming years, Richfield had a number of one-room schools scattered throughout the township (i.e. West Richfield School—now part of the Masonic Temple, No. 2 School—on Hawkins Road). In 1914, Richfield combined all their local schools into one, Richfield High School, located on Rt. 303. The students were known as the Richfield Rockets.

## Bath

**Township**—The first permanent settlers, Jonathan Hale and Jason Hammond came in 1810, and eight years after that, 1818, the township was officially organized. When the township first formed, the big question was what to call it. Jonathan Hale is alleged to have said, "Call it Jerusalem, Jericho, or Bath, or anything but Hammondsburgh (the name the township had become known as)." After a vote by the residents, the township was officially named Bath.

**Schools**—From 1877 to 1923, the township had 11 one-room schoolhouses (including Ira School, McAllister School, East Bath School, Hammond's Corners School, Ghent School and Bath Center School). In 1923, all of the one-room schools closed and the centrally located Bath School opened its doors. Bath School was a K-12 building located on the corner of Cleveland-Massillon and Bath Roads. The students were known as the Bath Buccaneers.

## Revere

In 1949, discussions began between Bath and Richfield regarding the consolidation of their two school districts started. On November 14, 1949, Summit County Board of Education officially recognized the new system and named it the "Bath-Richfield Local School District. In the early part of 1950, The Bath-Richfield School Board supervised the purchase of 28 acres for the site of the new school at the intersection of Revere and Everett Roads. While the school was being built, high school students spent half a day at Bath School and half a day at Richfield School.

On October 5, 1950, the school board selected "Revere High School" as the name for the new school. The name—which was eventually also selected as the name of the school district—was first suggested by long time teacher and coach Gordan E. Knapp based on the road the new school was being build on. On November 13, 1950, the students voted Red, White, and Blue as the district's colors and "Minutemen" was selected as the mascot based on the inspiration of the new name of the school. On May 29, 1952 the first graduating class of the Revere Local School District held their commencement in the Richfield School auditorium.

# History of Revere High School

## Forming of the School and Early Days

In the early part of 1950, The Bath-Richfield School Board supervised the purchase of 28 acres for the site of the new school at the intersection of Revere and Everett Roads. On October 5, 1950, the school board selected "Revere High School" as the name for the new school. The name was first suggested by long time teacher and coach Gordan E. Knapp based on the road the new school was being build on. Revere would also eventually be selected as the name of the actual school district school district. On November 13, 1950, the students voted Red, White, and Blue as the district's colors and "Minutemen" was selected as the mascot based on the inspiration of the new name of the school.

The school began construction in August of 1951. Starting in September of 1951, students spent half a day at Bath School and half a day at Richfield School while the school was being built, high school. Publication of the *Revere Lantern* replaced the *Bath Hi-Spy* and the *Richfield Echo*. The yearbook became the *Revere Review* and in ??? was changed to the *Reverie*. Over the next year, there was a complete union of all school activities, functions, and faculty. Mr. M. Pugh was the first Superintendent and Harold Schweiserberger was the first principal.

On May 29, 1952 the first graduating class of Revere held their commencement in the Richfield School auditorium. In February of 1952 the alma mater, *Revere Revere*, was chosen. The music was composed by Professor David T. Plank (a former Bath Resident) and the words were written by his mother, Mrs. Eulalia Plank. The Revere PTA was formed on March 31, 1953 with Mrs. L. Wyatt serving as the first president. The Revere Alumni Association (RAA) was formed in July of 1953 by Mike McCoy, Wanda Barthlomew, and Craig Richmond.

Starting in the fall of 1961, Revere High School became a 10-12 school after the freshmen began attending Eastview Junior High. The Freshmen returned in 1975.

## Statistics at the Schools Opening

## The Building

On June 17, 1951, a ground breaking ceremony was held for the new high school and construction began in August of 1951.

On January 20, 1953, all high school students moved into the new school. The original school was two floors and currently makes up the main two hallways of the current school. The cafeteria was up and running by the Fall of 1953. A gymnasium and auditorium were built and finished by December of 1953. (Note: In the current school—the original classroom section makes up the main two hallways, the gymnasium is now the Auxiliary Gym, the auditorium is now the band and chorus rooms). The official dedication of the school occurred on March 21, 1954.

In the Spring of 1957, an addition was added to Revere High School. The addition extended the building further west and added an industrial arts shop and several classrooms.

In 1981, an addition was added to RHS. The addition added a new gymnasium, locker rooms, auditorium, enlarged the cafeteria, added an elevator, and added classrooms to the art wing. [Note: the old gym became the library].

# Miscellaneous History of Revere High School

## Senior Rock

The original rock was excavated from the original Revere High School foundation, it was too big to haul away so they placed it on the corner of Revere and Everett Roads. It received its first paint job shortly after the school opened. In 1968, however, students did not stop at painting the rock and began to paint the school as well. In response, the school board ordered the rock removed so a hole was dug and the rock was buried. But mysteriously a new rock reappeared. Several seniors from the class of '68 got a truck with a crane and transported a rock from Canton to Revere. Administration threatened to haul the new rock away but a petition by the students saved the rock.



## RHS Marquee

The marquee was constructed in 1984 in memory of Marianne Mertie. She died in February 1992 in a car accident—she was a senior at Revere.



## Gordon E. Knapp Memorial Addition

The RHS student council dedicated the new auditorium and main gym area to Gordon E. Knapp in 1981. Knapp was a teacher, coach, and principal in the district from 1941 to 1980. The day before Mr. Knapp officially retired, was involved in a fatal car crash on his way home.




## RHS Entrance Tee

- Strazinsky Tree: The was planted in 1992 in memory of Becky Strazinsky. She died September 24, 1983 in a car accident—she was a senior at Revere.
- Flowers and Shrubs: The Revere Alumni Association designed and built the landscape at the entrance.
- Benches: The benches were an Eagle Scout Project of Michael A. Vince along with the planting of shrubbery.
- Revere Sign: The concrete Revere Sign was a gift from the Class of 2008 and the RHS Student Council.



## William E. Moats Entrance Tee

The was planted in 19?? in memory of Eric Morant. Eric graduated from RHS in 1990 and was a key member of the 1989 championship football team. Eric was killed in a fatal car crash.

## Veterans Memorial

The RHS Veterans Memorial is located between the football, baseball, and soft-ball fields. The Revere War Memorial was dedicated in recognition of all Revere alumni and staff who have defended their country through service in the Armed Forces of The United States of America. The first phase was completed by Kevin Papp as an eagle scout project in 2008 and included a walkway, two benches and a flag pole. The second phase was completed by David Morar as an eagle scout project in 2010 and includes 2 additional flag poles and a tree planted in memory of Gunnery Sergeant Robert Gilbert II.





# **History of Revere Athletics**

## **Revere Sports**

Prior to there being a Revere, there was Bath Buccaneers and the Richfield Rockets. The two different districts had a number of sports and actually competed against each other in the Summit County League.

In 1950, the two districts decided to combine—starting with the 1950 football team. Basketball would combine the following year. And in 1952, permanent sports department was established with Kermit Smulbach serving as the athletic director. The school sponsored football, cheerleading, men's basketball, men's track, and baseball. Football, track, and baseball competition were held at Bath Field while basketball was held at Richfield Gymnasium.

Girls at Revere, with the exception of cheerleading, did not have organized sports sponsored by the Athletic Department. But Bath and Richfield girls combined to become Revere's Y-Teens. Y-Teens (formerly Girl Reserves) is a club that is affiliated with the Youth Women's Christian Association (YMCA). There was 29 local high schools that had Y-Teen clubs. Revere girls first competed in swimming and basketball in 1952 and other sports were added through the years.

In 1972-1973, girl's sports were added to Suburban League competition.

## **Revere Groups/Clubs**

On March 28, 1952, Booster Club reorganized under the name Revere—Carl Deitrich served as the first president.

Varsity R Club was formed in 1954 (called the Lettermen's Club). It was organized by Coach Frank DiNapoli and was open to all those who have received a letter for football, basketball, baseball, track, and managing any of the sports—Bob Wells served as the as the first Student-President of the organization.

## **Ohio High School Athletic Association**

The Ohio High School Athletic Association is a voluntary, unincorporated, not-for-profit association of public and private high schools. The impetus for the founding of the Ohio High School Athletic Association came from the Western Ohio Superintendents Round Table as a result of discussions in the 1890's and early 1900's. At the March, 1906, meeting of the Round Table, a resolution was adopted to appoint a committee headed by George R. Eastman of Steele High School in Dayton. The OHSAA started with five districts in 1907, but soon changed to six districts in 1908. The OHSAA sponsors state championships in 11 boys sports and 11 girls sports as a result of that humble beginning of one in 1908.

# **History of Revere Athletics**

## **Revere Facilities**

### **Football/Track/Soccer**

- Originally the Minutemen football team and track team held their competitions at Bath School on Bath Field. In the fall of 1955, construction on a new field. The field was located at Revere High School, at the corner of Everett and Revere Roads, and include a new lighted field and track.
- On October 31, 1958, Revere High School Football Field was officially dedicated.
- On September 8, 1962 a dedication ceremony was held to commemorate the completion of a number of projects to the field, including new 1,200 seat steel bleachers.
- In 1994 the stadium received a major facelift with addition of new visitor bleachers, an all-weather track, new permanent fencing around the field and stadium, and paving around the stadium to replace the gravel.
- In 2002, new home bleachers were added along with an impressive press box.
- In 2002, the stadium was rededicated and named after longtime football coach, Joseph F. Pappano.
- In 2009, the stadium received field turf, an expanded playing surface, new visitor bleachers, a new all-weather track, new fencing, and new paving around the stadium.

### **Basketball/Wrestling/Volleyball**

- The home for winter sports was the Richfield Gymnasium.
- In 1953, a gymnasium was added on the 1-year old Revere high school.
- In 1981, a major addition was added to RHS. The addition added a new gymnasium, locker rooms, multipurpose room (wrestling and gymnastics room).
- In 1995, an Auxiliary Gym was added by converting the library to a gymnasium.

### **Baseball/Softball**

- The home of the baseball team was originally Bath Field (Richfield Field was “too tough because it was scraped too much”).
- In 1961 a new baseball field was built at the current high school (where the current softball field is located). In 1968, spectator stands were built.
- In 1972 a new baseball field was built at its current location, next to the bus garage and the old baseball field was converted to a softball field.
- The baseball and softball fields underwent major facelifts in 2004 when both fields

## Winter (year it became a sport at Revere and year it became a OHSAA recognized sport)

- **Boys' Basketball—1952 (OHSAA—1928)**
- **Girls' Basketball—1972 (OHSAA—1976)**
  - Women played against each other in “Y-Teens League” hosted at the YWCA starting in 1952
- **Wrestling—1957 (OHSAA—1938)**
  - No team in 1958 and 1959
  - No team in 1963 to 1968
- **Gymnastics—1972 (OHSAA—1977)**
  - There was a girls' team formed in 1972 but there is currently no team, occasionally some girls will compete individually and represent Revere (the latest in 2001).
  - In 1990, Mark Webber competed in gymnastics as a representative of Revere.
- **Boys' Swimming—1997 (OHSAA—1928)**
- **Girls Swimming—1997 (OHSAA—1977)**
  - A team existed for several years participating in the “Y-Teens League” host by the YWCA starting in 1952 but only last a few years.
  - A team was restarted in 1972, but once again it only lasted several years.

## Spring (year it became a sport at Revere and year it became a OHSAA recognized sport)

- **Baseball—1952 (OHSAA—1928)**
  - No team in 1955 and 1956
- **Softball—1973 (OHSAA—1978)**
  - Softball transitioned from slow-pitch to fast-pitch
- **Boys' Track—1952 (OHSAA—1908)**
- **Girls' Track—1977 (OHSAA—1978)**
- **Boys' Tennis—1969 (OHSAA—1922 [Individual/Doubles only, no Team championships])**
- **Boys' Lacrosse—2011 (OHSAA—N/A)**
  - Established as an independent club team in 1994, became a school recognized club sport in 2004, and will become a school sponsored sport in 2011.
- **Girls' Lacrosse—2011 (OHSAA—N/A)**
  - Established as an independent club team in 1996, became a school recognized club sport in 2004, and will become a school sponsored sport in 2011.



# REVERE MINUTEMEN

On October 5, 1950, the Bath-Richfield school board selected “Revere High School” as the name for the new combined high school. The name, which was eventually also selected as the name of the school district, was first suggested by long time teacher and coach Gordan E. Knapp based on the road the new school was being built on—Revere Road. On November 13, 1950, the students voted Red, White, and Blue as the district’s colors and “Minutemen” was selected as the mascot based on the inspiration of the new name of the school and the colors.



Revere’s initial logo for the mascot was based on *The Minute Man*, a statue by Daniel Chester French erected in 1875 in Concord, Massachusetts. This image still serves as the official logo for RHS and is used in the school’s emblem. (L-R): Official Logo, *The Minute Man* statue, and the school emblem.




The picture that appears to the left is the current logo used by the Revere Athletic Department. The remaining pictures are samples of what different RHS sports have used over the years.



## REVERE "R"

Revere has used a number of different style R's to represent the district over the years—some were official and some were not. In recent years, the district has adopted the Magneto Font **R** as the official style for Revere. The initial concept of the Magneto **R** was introduced by RHS student Tyler Thurn in the Spring of 2003 when he proposed to redesign the football helmets under new coach Terry Cistone. Cistone and Thurn modified the **R** slightly and the Magneto **R** was used on the helmet in the Fall of 2003. Over the next 5 years, the district unofficially adopted it as the Official R—the Revere "**R**".

The logo that appears to the left is the official Revere "R". The remaining logos are samples of what had been used over the years.



# The History of the Suburban League

The Suburban League is an outgrowth of the old Summit County League. The Summit League consisted of 13 schools including: Bath (Revere), Richfield (Revere), Greensburg (Green), Boston Township (Woodridge), Northfield-Macedonia (Nordonia), Copley, Twinsburg, Manchester, Hudson, and Mogadore.

In 1949 the larger schools in the league—Copley, Greensburg (Green), Hudson, Manchester, and Northfield-Macedonia (Nordonia)—formed the Suburban League while the smaller schools remained in the Summit County League. The League operated with the original five schools for eight years although Highland (formerly Sharon-Granger) did participate in the League in football. In 1958—Revere, Boston Township (Woodridge), Mogadore, and Twinsburg (Chamberlin)—merged to make the league nine teams.

The Suburban League existed with nine schools until 1964 when Twinsburg (Chamberlain) left to join the Chagrin Valley Conference. The league introduced the All-Sports Trophy in 1967-1968 which is awarded to the school that does the best in all sports competitions. Mogadore withdrew following the 1967-68 school year to join the Portage County League. The league operated with seven schools until Coventry left the Metropolitan League to become a member in 1969-1970.

In 1972-1973, girl's sports were added to Suburban League competition—they had previously competed in Y-Teens as part of the YWCA.

When Norton withdrew from the Metropolitan League and was admitted to membership in 1972-73, the league again had nine members. But Nordonia withdrew the following season to become a member of the Metropolitan League.

Highland joined the league when Manchester opted to join the All-Ohio Conference in 1976. Field replaced Woodridge in 1978, and when Coventry left to join the All-Ohio Conference following the 1982-83 school year, the league again operated with seven schools. Wadsworth was admitted to membership in December of 1981 and began actively participating in the fall of 1984.

In 1990, Field withdrew from the league to join the Portage County League and Tallmadge left the Metropolitan League to join the Suburban League.

After the 1996-97 season, Hudson left the league to join the Western Reserve Conference. Cloverleaf High School withdrew from the Pioneer Conference and began Suburban League competition in the 1997-98 school year.

In 2005, Norton left to join the new two-tier 16-school Portage Trail Conference. Barberton withdrew from the Western Reserve Conference and joined the Suburban League.

In 2011, Barberton left the league to become independent and the Nordonia Knights (an original member 1949-1973) withdrew from the Northeast Ohio Conference to rejoin the Suburban League—forming the eight member league as it exists today.

In 2015, big changes will occur to the Suburban League. First, Green will leave the conference to become a member of the Federal League and Cloverleaf will leave the conference to become a member of the Portage Trail Conference. Second, the league will expand into one 7-team and one 8-team division—high school based upon enrollment (National Division-Big School and American Division-Small School) while middle school based on geography (Northeast and Southwest). The expansion will see three former members return: Hudson (1949-1996), Twinsburg (1958-1963), and Barberton (2005-2010). It also will welcomed six new members into the league: Stow-Monroe Falls, North Royalton, Cuyahoga Falls, Brecksville-Broadview Heights, Kent Roosevelt, and Aurora.

**NATIONAL DIVISION (HS-Big School):** Stow (1,338), North Royalton (1,334), Hudson (1,250), Cuyahoga Falls (1,217), Wadsworth (1,183), Brecksville (1,163), Twinsburg (1,090) and Nordonia (1,018)

**AMERICAN DIVISION (HS-Small School):** Barberton (931), Roosevelt (881), Highland (873), Copley (867), Aurora (787), Revere (679) and Tallmadge (633).



**Northeast Conference (MS):** Aurora, Cuyahoga Falls, Hudson, Nordonia, Roosevelt, Stow, Tallmadge and Twinsburg.

**Southwest Conference (MS):** Barberton, Brecksville, Copley, Highland, North Royalton, Revere and Wadsworth.



# History of Revere Baseball

The tradition starts with the forming of a school baseball team shortly after the building of Bath School in 1892. They, along with other sports teams at Bath, were known as the Buccaneers. Baseball was “the sport” at Bath around this time according to the *Lantern*. Prior to 1951, the Bath Buccaneers and the Richfield Rockets (Richfield did not have a baseball team) existed separately.

In November of 1949, the two communities decided to join districts and it was known as Bath-Richfield School District. While the school was being built, high school students spent half a day at Bath School and half a day at Richfield School. The communities started to combine sports teams in 1950 and were completely combined by 1952. On October 5, 1950, the school board selected “Revere High School” as the name for the new school and on November 13, 1950, the students voted Red, White, and Blue as the school’s colors.

In 1952, with Revere just having formed their Athletic Department, the Revere Baseball Program took shape. Kermit Smulbach served as the first coach and in 1954 the team captured the league title in only its 3rd year. The school then did not sponsor a team in 1955 and 1956.

A baseball team returned in 1957, under the guidance of Coach Jack Greynolds. Greynolds provided stability to the program and guided it for 9 years (1957-1965). The team was just slightly under .500 during the Greynolds’ years and captured a league title in 1965. The following three years (1966-1968) were a struggle, as the Minutemen won a total of 10 games in 3 years.

The program once again bounced back with the hiring of Coach Jerry Fry. Coach Fry reenergized the program, coaching with passion for the next 9 years (1969-1976). Fry’s teams always hovered around .500 and they captured the league title in 1972.

In 1977, Coach Charles Stark—a long time Fry assistant—took over the program. Coach Stark guided the Minutemen for 4 seasons and although they were unable to win a league title, they won 37 games, were just slightly under .500, and were the sectional champions in 1979.

In 1981, Coach Jeff Gibson—another long time assistant to both Fry and Stark—took over the program. Coach Gibson guided the Minutemen Baseball Program for 17 years (1981-1997). It is under Gibson that the Revere Baseball Program experienced its greatest success. In those 17 years, the program won 143 games, 5 league titles, and 4 sectional championships. Two of those teams rank as some of the top teams in the program’s history. The 1984 team went 18-1, which is tied

for the most wins program’s history and has the best winning percentage in program’s history. They won the league title, sectional championship, and lost a close game to GlenOak to just miss advancing to regional play. The 1985 team went 17-6, which is tied for second in wins in program’s history and second in winning percentage in program’s history. They too won a league title.

In 1998, Coach Jeff Dallas—long time coach at St. V-M—was hired. Coach Dallas guided the Revere Baseball Program for 7 years, winning two sectional championships. The highlight of these years were the 1999 and 2000 teams. The 1999 team went 13-11 with mostly underclassmen and lost to Walsh Jesuit in the Sectional Championship after they had the lead late in the game (Walsh went on to win the State Championship). The 2000 team went 17-7, which is tied for second in wins in program’s history. They finished second in the league, won the sectional championship, and lost a tough game to Olmsted Falls in the District Championship.

In 2005, Coach Phil Heyn took over the program. He was a former All-Suburban League shortstop for the Minutemen (1995 and 1996) under Coach Jeff Gibson and also an assistant under Coach Jeff Dallas (2001-2004). Coach Heyn coached for six years before stepping down and becoming the head football coach at Revere. Under Heyn, the program won 10+ games each season and captured two sectional championships. In 2008, the team went 18-11 and they lost a tough District Championship game to Medina Highland to just miss advancing to Regional’s. The 2009 team went 18-8 and the 2010 team went 19-8 to set a new school record for wins in a season.

In 2011, Coach Jason Cottrell became the 10th coach in Minutemen Baseball history. He is a former all-league performer for the Field Falcons and a three-year letter winner for Mount Union. He has coached at Revere, Lake, and Tallmadge (helping win the 2002 D-II State Championship).



## Revere Baseball Head Coach Profiles 1952-1976



### Kermit Smulbach—1952-1954—1-3

Kermit Smulbach was the first baseball coach and football coach in Revere History. He had previously coached the Bath Buccaneers. As the baseball coach at Revere, he was 1-3 and won the Suburban League title in 1954. He also coached football (3-20-2 in three seasons) and taught physical education. Prior to coaching at Bath, Coach Smulbach coached at Coventry where he was 4-19-2 in three years (1942-1944). After Revere, Smulbach moved on to coach at Brunswick where he went 5-18 in three years.



### Jack Greynolds—1957-1965—35-26

Jack Greynolds was hired at Revere in 1957 where he coached baseball and basketball. As a baseball coach, he was 26-35 and won the Suburban League title in 1966. As a basketball coach at Revere, he won or co-champed the Suburban league eight times.

Coach Greynolds primary sport was basketball and he had plenty of success as the head basketball coach. His coaching career included 12 years at Revere High School (1957-1969), and 17 years at Barberton High School (1969-1987). Over all his high school teams won 549 and lost 121 for 82.9%. They won 16 sectional, six district, three regional and one State Championship. Barberton won the State Championship in 1976 and was runner-up in 1977 and 1982.

He was selected Summit County Coach of the Year an unprecedented 5 times and named Dapper Dan Man of the Year in 1977. Greynolds has been inducted into the Barberton Sports Hall of Fame, the Summit County Sports Hall of Fame, Greater Akron Hall of Fame, the Ohio High School Athletic Association Hall of Fame. Jack Greynolds was named the Greatest High School Coach in Summit County in the last 50 years by the Summit County Sports Hall of Fame Committee and a vote of the public.


Coach Greynolds had to give up coaching in 1987 when he suffered a stroke. Coach Greynolds passed away January 14, 2005.

### John Fuller—1967-1968—8-12

John Fuller was only the coach for one year but he made large contributions to Revere Athletics in other areas (22 years as girls track coach, 2 years as head football coach with four years as assistant, and 2 years as assistant girls basketball coach). In his career, he spent 24 years teaching math and 18 years as athletic director.



### Jerry Fry—1969-1976—54-71


Jerry Fry was a standout athlete in high school and college. At Mogadore, he lettered in football, basketball, track and baseball. Coach Fry went on to play baseball at Bowling Green State University. He was a social studies teacher who first started in Cuyahoga Falls for one year before coming to Revere in 1966. Coach Fry was an assistant football coach for several years and eventually took over the baseball program. Coach Fry reenergized the program, coaching with passion for the next 9 years (1969-1976). Fry's teams always hovered around .500 and they captured the league title in 1972. He finished his career as a guidance counselor. Two of Coach Fry's sons currently teach in the Revere School District (Jeff—history teacher at the high school and Dan—assistant principle at Hillcrest).



### Charles Stark—1977-1980—37-38

Charles Stark attended Green high school, where he played baseball, and then received his college degree from the University of Akron. He started at Revere in 1977 and taught for 35 years before retiring in 2012. Coach Stark coached the Junior Varsity baseball team for five years before becoming the head coach in 1977. He guided the Minutemen for 4 seasons and although they were unable to win a league title, they won 37 games, were just slightly under .500, and were the sectional champions in 1979. Coach Stark was also extremely active in Revere Youth Sports (baseball & basketball) acting as a coach and administrator.

### Jeff Gibson—1981-1997—141-181

Coach Jeff Gibson played baseball at Manchester and graduated in 1964. He attended BGSU. He began his teaching career at Revere in 1971. He was the junior varsity coach for 8 years (1973-1980) before taking over the program in 1981. He would then guide the Minutemen Baseball Program for the next 17 years (1981-1997). It is under Gibson that the Revere Baseball Program experienced its greatest success. In those 17 years, the program won 143 games, 5 league titles, and 4 sectional championships. His 1984 team went 18-1, which is tied for the most wins program's history and has the best winning percentage in program's history. They won the league title, sectional championship, and lost a close game to GlenOak to just miss advancing to regional play. Coach Gibson was also the head cross country coach for 25 years (1982-2007). The Boys won two suburban league championships (1998 and 1999), one regional runner-up title, and made one state appearance. The girls won one suburban league championship (2005), won numerous district titles, won five regional titles, and had seven state appearances. In 2011, Coach Gibson was inducted into the Northeast Ohio Baseball Coaches Association's Hall of Fame.



### Jeff Dallas—1998-2004—73-90 (Overall: 156-128)

Jeff Dallas played baseball at St. Vincent from 1985-87 where he helped the Fighting Irish win a State Championship in 1986 (1st Summit County team to win a Baseball Championship). In that same year, he was All-City DH and All-Diamond Conference OF; Also was starting center on football team. Coach Dallas became a head coach in 1990 when he took over the St. V's Baseball Program. From 1990-94, he compiled a 83-38 record which included 1 State Final Four/Regional Championship, 3 District Championships, 3 Diamond Conference Championships, and was twice named Diamond Conference Coach of the Year. He was an assistant at Copley for 3 years before becoming the head coach at Revere in 1998. Coach Dallas guided the Revere Baseball Program for 7 years, winning two sectional championships. The highlight of these years were the 1999 and 2000 teams. The 1999 team went 13-11 with mostly underclassmen and lost to Walsh Jesuit in the Sectional Championship after they had the lead late in the game (Walsh went on to win the State Championship). The 2000 team went 17-7, which is tied for second in wins in program's history. They finished second in the league, won the sectional championship, and lost a tough 5-4 game to Olmsted Falls in the District Championship.



### Phil Heyn—2005-2010—89-69

Phil Heyn grew up in Bath and is a graduate of Revere. He was a three-year letter winner, all-league performer, and a captain in baseball and football. After high school he attended Ohio Wesleyan University and was a three-year letter winner and co-captain in football. Upon graduation, he returned to Revere where he became a history teacher and an assistant football and baseball coach. He served as an assistant baseball coach for four years before becoming the head baseball coach in 2005.

Coach Heyn coached for six years before stepping down and becoming the head football coach at Revere. Under Heyn, the program won 10+ games each season and captured two sectional championships. In 2008, the team went 18-11 and they lost a tough District Championship game to Medina Highland to just miss advancing to Regional's. The 2009 team went 18-8 and the 2010 team went 19-8 to set a new school record for wins in a season.



### Jason Cottrell—2011-PRESENT—38-91

In 2011, Coach Jason Cottrell became the 10th coach in Minutemen Baseball history. He is a former all-league performer for the Field Falcons and a three-year letterwinner for Mount Union. He has coached at Revere, Lake, and Tallmadge (helping win the 2002 D-II State Championship).

## Revere Baseball Facilities: Revere Stadium

Field—Revere originally played on Bath Field (Richfield Field was “too tough because it was scraped too much”). Bath Field was eventually redone in the mid-1950s to accommodate the new Revere High School Baseball team.

In 1961 a new baseball field was built at the current high school (where the current softball field is located).

In 1972 a new baseball field was built at its current location, next to the bus garage. This field was had no outfield fence, no dugouts, and the outfield doubled at the football practice field in the fall (which made for some interesting hops in the spring).

In 1987 the dugouts were built and in the early 90s a temporary outfield fence began to be used (originally a snow fence, then a mesh netting, and then finally a chain-linked fence). The field then received another upgrade in 2002 when a grass infield was added to the field.

The field received a major face lift in 2004, when the field became a baseball only facility: permanent 10 foot fencing was put in around the field; storage, bleachers, and a batting cage were also added.

**COLLEGE SENIOR SEASON:** Joe Corfman was selected First Team All-MAC, making him only the 31<sup>st</sup> player in Toledo history to earn all-league laurels on more than one occasion. Prior to the season he was selected as a Pre-season All-Buckeye State Baseball Second Team Selection. Corfman led or shared the team lead in eight categories - batting average (.333), hits (78), runs scored (52), doubles (16), total bases (105), on-base percentage (.404), slugging percentage (.449) and stolen bases (22). Corfman hit safely in a team high 44 of the 57 games, reached base in 52 of the 57 games, and had 23 multi-hit games.

**COLLEGE JUNIOR YEAR:** Playing through injuries, appeared in 48 games, making 47 starts (26 at third base and 21 at shortstop. Academic All-MAC and Tabbed as most underrated hitter in MAC according to CollegeBaseballInsider.

**COLLEGE SOPHOMORE YEAR:** Started all 56 games (all at third base). American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/Rawlings All-Mideast Region first-team selection, first-team All-Mac, Academic All-MAC, a MAC Scholar-Athlete of the Week (Week of 4/11/10), and MAC West Division Player of the Week (Week of 5/16/2010).

**COLLEGE FRESHMEN YEAR:** Appeared in 45 games, making 38 starts (22 at designated hitter, 10 in left field, four at second base, one at first base, and one at third base).

**COLLEGE SINGLE SEASON RECORDS:** Corfman is making a run at many single season records this year (2012—currently eighth in stolen bases (22) and eight in hits (78), sixth in doubles (16) but he also holds numerous records from his 2010 season: second in runs scored (69), second in doubles (20), second in RBI (61), third in hits (88), and fifth in total bases (131).
