

CVEEC PARENT VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP

PLEASE NOTE: For the safety of our students, Revere Local School District requires all volunteers be fingerprinted for a BCI background check as well as an FBI background check. Please refer to the information on the back of this sheet for specifics. For this event, completed background checks must be received at the Board Office no later than Friday, October 6, 2023. (It usually takes approximately 10 days to receive results, so please plan accordingly.)

Parents who have previously been fingerprinted and have the certificates on file in the School Board office are “grandfathered” and WILL NOT need to have the service done. If you are not sure if your certificate is on file or have questions regarding fingerprinting, please contact Carie Raymond at craymond@revereschools.org.

Parent chaperones are vital to the success of this program. Without enough volunteers, this trip simply cannot take place. Below is an example of the shifts that are available for each session. Please note that you will be expected to work the entire shift for which you volunteered.

- Day 1: 9:00AM – 1:00PM Check-in, Morning activities, Lunch
- Day 1: 1:00PM – 5:00PM Afternoon activities, Afternoon snack
- Day 1: 5:00PM – 9:00PM Dinner, Outdoor Evening activities
- Day 1: 9:00PM – Overnight Spend the night, Breakfast
- Day 2: 9:00AM – 1:00PM Morning activities, Lunch, Check-out

- “On-call” substitute in case of last minute volunteer cancellations.

- Serve as part of the volunteer medical staff.

If you are interested in serving as a volunteer, please use your mobile device to scan the appropriate QR code or visit the website shown below. All shifts are assigned on a first come, first served basis, and we do our best to ensure that all “approved” chaperones are given at least one shift with their child(ren).

In an attempt to offer an opportunity to multiple parents, we ask that you sign up for just ONE shift at this time. If after the initial offering there are any unfilled shifts, notification will be sent allowing interested parties to volunteer for additional assignments. You will be contacted by the “Chaperone Coordinator” at a later date with the specifics of your actual assignment(s).

Volunteering at Revere Local Schools

To: District Parents/Guardians/Others
Re: Safety and Security of Our Students

The Revere Local School District requires all regular adult volunteers to be fingerprinted per our Board policy. The list below is a guide to specific categories requiring fingerprinting.

Those who volunteer in the following positions must be fingerprinted:

- Office or library volunteer
- Birthday Book Club volunteer
- Classroom helpers / tutors / volunteers
- Anyone who volunteers and is unsupervised with children on a regular basis
- Anyone attending a field trip
- Room parents
- Any substitutes to the above positions
- Other - at the Superintendent's discretion

***Simply attending a classroom party or school program as a parent, or dropping off food/drinks DOES NOT require fingerprinting.**

NEW volunteers need BOTH the BCI (Ohio) and the FBI (National) background checks (fingerprinting). You may go anywhere that offers Webcheck (electronic) printing. We frequently use Accurate Investigative Services in Akron and Alpha Background Investigations in Copley. In addition, the Revere Administration Office offers this service by appointment. DUE BY FRIDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2023.

Once you have been fingerprinted and we have received adequate reports for both the BCI and FBI printing, you are welcome to volunteer in all the Revere schools. **You will not need to repeat this process as long as you continue to volunteer in the Revere Local Schools year after year - this is subject to change.** A break in service will require new background checks.

You MAY NOT begin to volunteer in the areas noted above until the Superintendent has received adequate BCI and FBI REPORTS - NO EXCEPTIONS!

The Superintendent will discreetly contact any person who is not permitted to volunteer due to a disqualifying offense on either fingerprint report.
