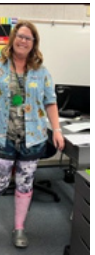
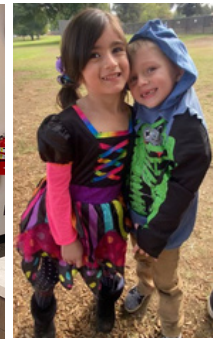
SUPERINTENDENT'S CORNER
