Provisional Internship Permit

DURATION OF LEG: 1 CALENDAR YEAR

- Bachelor's Degree:
 - Multiple Subject: 40 semester units including 10 units of course work in each of at least four subjects areas
 - Single Subject: 18 semester or 9 upper division of coursework in the subject of teaching assignment
 - Spec. Ed.: Same as Multi Sub & Single Sub or third option;
 9 units combination of Spec. Ed coursework & Gen Ed.
- Basic Skills Requirement:
 - CBEST or Course Evaluation

WHO APPLIES FOR IT? DISTRICT



If you are on a PIP, you need to submit PROGRESS to qualify for a STSP to receive a contract to return next school year.

Examples of Proof of Progress:

- Acceptance Letter into Credential Program
- Transcripts showing completed credential coursework
- Passing Score for TPAs, CSETs, or RICA




SHORT - TERM STAFF PERMIT

DURATION OF LEG: 1 ACADEMIC YEAR

- Bachelor's Degree:
 - See Requirements on Next <u>Fast Forward</u> Slide
- Basic Skills Requirement:
 - CBEST or Course Evaluation

YOU DO **NOT** QUALIFY FOR A PIP IF YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING:

• MULTIPLE SUBJECT OR SPECIAL EDUCATION:


- o If you earned a bachelor's degree in one of the following:
 - Liberal Studies
 - Liberal Arts
 - Elementary Education

• **SINGLE SUBJECT OR SPECIAL EDUCATION:**

- If you earned a bachelor's degree in the subject area of your assignment (any will suffice for Spec. Ed) Examples include:
 - Art
 - English
 - Mathematics/Statistics Science
 - Music

- Social Science
- Business




If you are on a STSP, you need to submit PROOF of PROGRESS confirming you QUALIFY for an INTERN CREDENTIAL to receive a contract to return next school year.

Proof of Progress = Intern Credential posted on CTC

- To Qualify for an Intern Credential:
 - 100% Subject Matter Competency: Coursework/degree or passing ALL CSETs
 - Fulfilled 120 Pre-Service Hours including 45 EL Hours (complete through credential program)
 - U.S. Constitution Requirement
- ** All Requirements Must be Confirmed by Your University
- ** Must Be on Track with Mentoring Hours and Assignments




INTERN CREDENTIAL

DURATION OF LEG: 2 CALENDAR YEARS (typically)

- 100% Basic Skills Requirement
- 100% Subject Matter Competency: Coursework/degree or passing ALL CSETs
- Fulfilled 120 Pre-Service Hours including 45 EL Hours (complete through credential program)
- U.S. Constitution Requirement

WHO APPLIES FOR IT? UNIVERSITY



If you are on an Intern Credential for one or two years as a contracted teacher, you need to submit PROOF of PROGRESS confirming you QUALIFY FOR A PRELIMINARY CREDENTIAL to receive a contract to return the following year.

Proof of Progress = Preliminary Credential posted on CTC

• To Qualify for a Preliminary Credential:

- 100% Basic Skills Requirement
- 100% Subject Matter Competency: Coursework/degree or passing ALL CSETs
- Complete a Commission- approved credential program
- Pass the RICA (only applicable to Multiple Subject & Spec. Ed.)
- Pass TPA 1 & TPA 2
- U.S. Constitution Requirement
- CPR Requirement
- ** All Requirements Must be Confirmed by Your University
- ** Must Be on Track with Mentoring Hours and Assignments



GELAP/SELAP

General Education Limited Assignment Permit / Special Education Limited Assignment Permit

DURATION OF LEG: 1 CALENDAR YEAR

Gen Ed Authorization:

- Option 1: 20 Semester Units in Subject Area
- Option 2: Pass All Subject Matter CSETs AND complete 1 Methods course.
- *Can qualify for a 2nd year on GELAP if complete 6 semester units towards authorization <u>during current academic year</u> or take all CSETs and pass at least two

Spec. Ed Authorization:

 Complete required credential coursework through university

**Can qualify for a 2nd year on SELAP if complete 6 semester units towards authorization <u>during current academic</u> <u>year</u>

* Must also be on track with mentoring hours and assignments

PRELIM CREDENTIAL

DURATION OF LEG: 5 CALENDAR YEARS

- 100% Subject Matter Competency: Coursework/degree or passing ALL CSETs
- Complete a Commission- approved credential program within 2 years
- Pass the RICA (only applicable to Multiple Subject & Spec. Ed.)
- Pass TPA 1 & TPA 2
- U.S. Constitution Requirement
- CPR Requirement

INDUCTION



CURRENT YEAR

NEXT 1 - 2 YEARS

If you are on a Prelim Credential as a contracted teacher, you need to submit <u>PROOF of PROGRESS</u> confirming you <u>QUALIFY FOR A CLEAR CREDENTIAL</u> to receive a contract to return the following year.

• To Qualify for a Clear Credential:

- Stay on track with Year 1 and Year 2 induction timeline
- Complete all requirements
 - Complete all sections of your Individual Learning Plan for Year 1 and Year 2
 - Complete all inquiry cycles for Year 1 and Year 2
 - Complete all Program surveys
 - Attend all required professional development
 - Keep all mentoring documentation current, including acknowledging your hours
 - Attend End Of Program event
- ** All Requirements Must be Confirmed by Rafaela Lopez
- ** Must Be on Track with Mentoring Hours and Assignments
