

Class of 2026 - Course Selection FAQ's

Q: How many credits do I sign up for?

A: 8 total credits. You must sign up for 8 credits, even if we take something out in the future, for an approved special program.

Q: When is the course selection sheet due?

A: Course selection sheets are due to your advisory by 11/20/23.

Q: I'm interested in Dual Enrollment next year. How do I get started?

A: The student and parent should sign up for a virtual advising session on Dual Enrollment hosted by Carroll Community College. Open this link and scroll to #4: Dual Enrollment - Carroll Community College (carrollcc.edu)

Q: How do I sign up for a dual enrollment class at MVHS?

A: If you would like to take English 101, History 110, or Math 115 at MVHS next year, please indicate by marking them on your course selection sheet. This will help us gauge how many sections to offer at MVHS next year.

Q: What if I am interested in taking dual enrollment courses at Carroll Community College?

A: If you would like to take English 101, History 110, or Math 115 on-campus through Carroll Community College, you should mark them accordingly on your course selection sheet. If you would like to take MORE than just those courses, please check "Yes" on page 2 where it asks, "Are you interested in taking course on campus at Carroll Community College next year besides those already selected?".

DO NOT count these courses as part of your 8 credits – only check for interest. You should still pick 8 credits on your course selection sheet.

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Q: I am interested in doing an independent study or being an academic department assistant. How do I sign up for that?

A: You should check your interest in an independent study on your course selection sheet and still pick 8 total credits of courses. If interested in being an academic department assistant (teacher aide), you should talk to the teacher directly and if approved, get the application.

Q: I want to go to the Career and Technology Center or attend a Regional Program. How do I plan for this?

A: All of the CCCTC and Regional programs are listed on your Resource Sheet, along with a link and QR code to the CCCTC website. Applications for CCCTC are due by December 1, 2023. You can indicate the program(s) that you have or are planning to apply to on page 3 of your course selection sheet.

DO NOT count these courses as part of your 8 credits. You should still pick 8 credits on your course selection sheet. Counselors will follow up with students who are admitted into their programs after decisions are sent out, in January, to adjust course requests as needed.

Q: What is the Emergency Services Training Program?

A: This is a program available for seniors (and some juniors) that requires an application and acceptance. Only sign up if you have been approved. If you are interested but have not yet applied, please pick 8 credits and make an appointment with your school counselor to learn how to apply.

Q: What chorus class should I sign up for if auditions have not happened yet?

A: Sign up for the current chorus class you are in and if a change is needed after auditions, Ms. Warner will let the school counselor know.
