With new programs that focus on STEM, health and wellness, and after-school and summer activities, community partnerships that enhance internship and job-shadowing opportunities, and new facilities that benefit our students and the Southern Maryland community, the strategic plan is the cornerstone of our foundation for expanding our prevailing strengths and being open to the endless possibilities for the future. The New Donnie Williams Center Brings Health and Wellness Curriculum and Programs to Students, Staff and the Southern Maryland Community

In 2019 the Donnie Williams Center will open! The center will provide 48,000 square feet of modern, spacious facilities and health and wellness programs to benefit our students, staff and the Southern Maryland community. The facility will allow SMR to host academics events such as robotics competitions and speakers, enable the school to hold graduation ceremonies on campus, and will be the location for all-school Masses, dances, assemblies and school events.

Located on the upper campus, the center includes a stage, gathering spaces for students, multipurpose room, gymnasium, locker rooms, training facilities, concessions, campus store, outdoor patio and common area for students.

“Our new facility is a huge opportunity for our students and staff because it also allows us to offer new health and wellness curricula, including new class options for physical education, programs that support the active lifestyles of today’s teens and new benefits for our staff,” said President Mary Joy Hurlburt. “Also, during the school year, an intramural program will be available to all SMR students.”

With the increased facilities space on campus, the SMR summer camp program (Summer Knights) will expand its offerings. The facility will also be used for graduation ceremonies and all-school gatherings, and can host communitywide events such as robotics competitions and speakers.

“It’s an exciting time to be part of our community and to be able to offer these benefits to everyone — all of our students, staff, our student-athletes and the outside community,” said Principal Rick Wood.

The benefits to faculty and staff include access to fitness equipment, mindfulness and low-impact fitness classes and the opportunity to use the facilities before and after school.

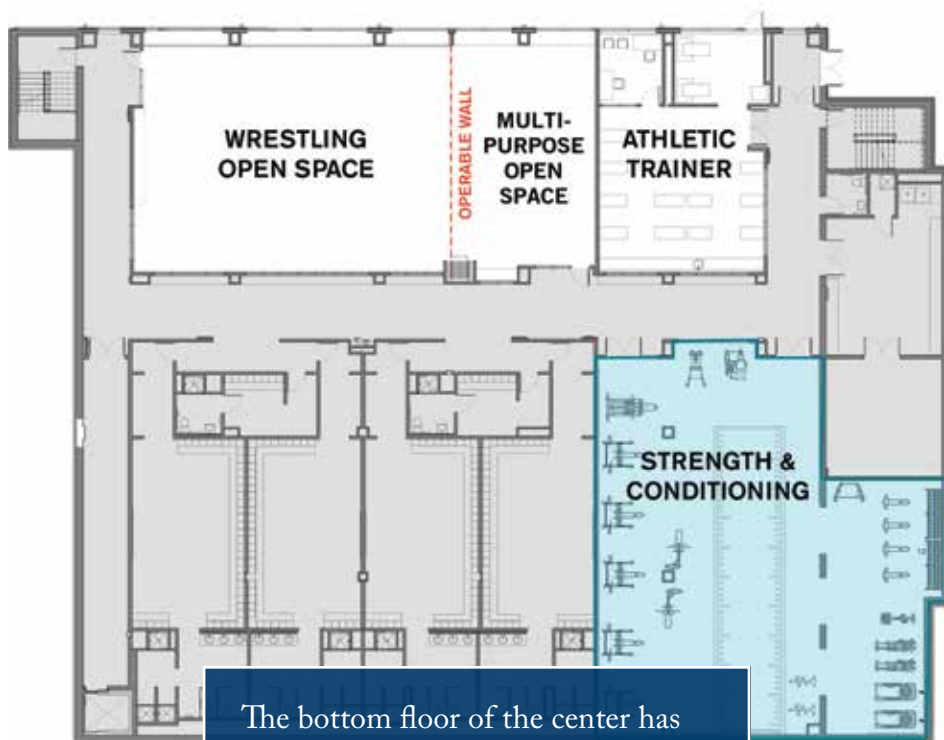
“Providing these additional benefits to our staff is just one more way we can thank

them for all of their care, compassion and commitment they provide our students every day,” said Mrs. Hurlburt.

Sage Dining Services, which offers food services in the SMR campus café, will provide healthy snack options in the new center after school.

“All of these on-campus enhancements support the new movement in education that students, parents and educators desire — a healthier lifestyle at school and work!” Mrs. Hurlburt said.

“We are very excited about the new facility because it will provide improved athletic

facilities to compete in the prestigious Washington Catholic Athletic Conference, and allow us to welcome the community to host their competitions and tournaments,” said Dr. Wood.

The facility is named after a member of the Ryken High School (RHS) Class of 1971, Donnie Williams, who held close all of his life the values he learned from the Xaverian

Brothers. “Mr. Williams let the values shape the person he would become as he grew through adolescence into a young man during his transformative years at RHS,” Mrs. Hurlburt said.

“This building and the programming that is forthcoming are examples of the strategic planning and continued commitment by SMR to providing space and the resources

A Time to Remember

Members from the Class of 1988 gathered at the end of October to celebrate their 30th reunion during Homecoming Weekend — a weekend of golf, happy hours, dancing and seeing old friends. Truly a joyful celebration filled with hugs, laughter and stories that began with “remember when...”

But when it came time to plan for their reunion last year, members of the reunion committee were facing tragedy. Three classmates had passed away within two months — two of them on the same day following Thanksgiving and a third just weeks into the new year.

As many gathered during this time for funerals, they reflected on the frailty of life and how their class had lost too many classmates so early in life — nine members deceased before the age of 48. Unimaginable.

But the class turned pain into beauty, into remembrance, into legacy.

David Bowes and Jef Graves came to St. Mary’s Ryken and asked how the Class of 1988 could dedicate a memorial to their classmates. With the Donnie Williams Center opening in 2019, SMR President Mary Joy Hurlburt suggested they dedicate a cozy green space surrounded by trees and flowers with a bench to soothe the soul — a place to find peace, a place to remember, not just high school days, but the friendships and the people who have touched their lives; a place that will continue to flourish and leave its own indelible mark at St. Mary’s Ryken.

Thank You to the Rigby Family!

The Rigby family established a scholarship fund this year in memory of their parents, Alice King Rigby (SMA '52) and Kenneth Rigby. The gift, along with every named scholarship gift, represents gratefulness of St. Mary's Ryken's impact on their family. In addition, these gifts allow students to attend SMR who might otherwise not have the resources for such an impactful educational opportunity.

LOVE REMEMBERED

A new scholarship to St. Mary's Ryken honors the memory of 1952 St. Mary's Academy (SMA) graduate Alice King Rigby and her husband Ken Rigby, both longtime residents of Southern Maryland.

The scholarship was established by Alice and Ken's son, Michael Rigby, a 1981 graduate of Ryken High School (RHS), and his wife, Wendy. The annual award will go to an incoming freshman with an aptitude for math.

"Education was very important to both my parents," Michael said. "I was fortunate to have received an excellent education at Ryken and I wanted to give something back. A scholarship in my parents' memory was a good way to do this."

Michael was born and raised in Leonardtown, Maryland. After attending Leonard Hall Junior Naval Academy, he attended RHS. Michael said, "I have many fond memories of living in Leonardtown and attending RHS. I enjoyed many things during my years at Ryken, including Brother Rom's math and science classes, the debate team, the senior play, but especially the friends I made during these years. I come from a very large extended family local to Southern Maryland so family gatherings at Christmas and Easter at the Sterling house were always a lot of fun."

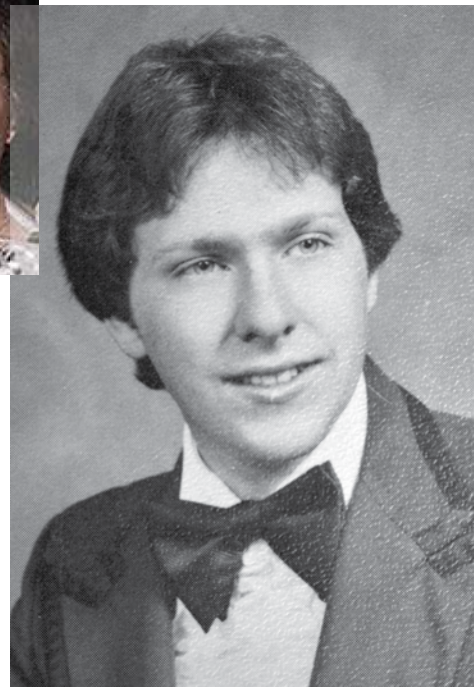

His mother, Alice, also was born and raised in Leonardtown, graduating from SMA. Alice and her brother, Leo, were brought up by their grandparents, Ruth and Lynwood Sterling. Alice worked as an administrative assistant for the Cooperative Extension Service. She was a member of the Lady Lions, the Venture Club and Epsilon Sigma Phi organization of Extension professionals. Alice was an assistant to the Electrical Examiners Board of St. Mary's County for 17 years.

Alice's husband, Ken, was born in Boston and joined the Navy at age 18 during the Korean War. He traveled throughout the world before being stationed at Patuxent River. Ken met Alice through her aunt, and they married and lived in Leonardtown.

Michael Rigby '81



Ken attended St. Mary's College for two years and then transferred to Towson, where he received his degree in teaching. He was a member of the Lions Club and was involved in other community groups.

Michael met his wife, Wendy, at Georgetown University, where they both received degrees

in mathematics. They married during graduate school and became actuaries. Today, Michael has moved into the field of information technology, and they live in New Jersey.

Michael and Wendy, who have lived in New Jersey most of their adult lives, have three children, the youngest of whom just started college, so they are adjusting to being empty nesters. Their son, Jonathan, attended The College of William & Mary and graduated with a degree in mathematics. He is now a graduate student at Yale University pursuing a dual degree in divinity and environmental science. Their oldest daughter, Kali, is a senior at Brown University studying chemistry, and their youngest daughter, Sabrina, just started college at Northeastern University.

With a strong foundation in education that led to a successful career, Michael wanted to do something to honor his parents' memory and the sacrifices they made for him.

In December 2017, Michael and Wendy created the *Alice King Rigby '52 & Ken Rigby Scholarship* at St. Mary's Ryken. The scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman with an aptitude for math. This generous gift is an enduring legacy of the importance of education that honors Michael's parents and combines a personal

passion for math. Both Michael and Wendy have careers in STEM fields. "A STEM education can offer a student many opportunities for their future," he said. Michael also purchased the first 3-D printer for SMR in 2016, which benefits all our students in math and sciences, but especially our engineering students and robotics club.

Alice's best friend (and St. Mary's Academy classmate) was Mary Ada Candela. The two were inseparable and had many adventures while in school and afterwards. Mary Ada said, "She was just the loveliest person I have known." Heartbroken after Alice died in November 2006, she remembers she picked up Alice's Sacred Heart badge from her nightstand and put it in her coat pocket, worried someone might throw it away. A year later she was in a near-fatal car crash on St. Andrews Church Road. "The police officer said I was the luckiest person in the world." As she was waiting for her husband Jack to pick her up, she put her hand in her coat pocket, felt something unfamiliar, pulled it out, and there was Alice's Sacred Heart badge that she had placed in her pocket a year prior. A friend said, "Well, Alice flew with you the whole time she was alive, and she is still with you today."
