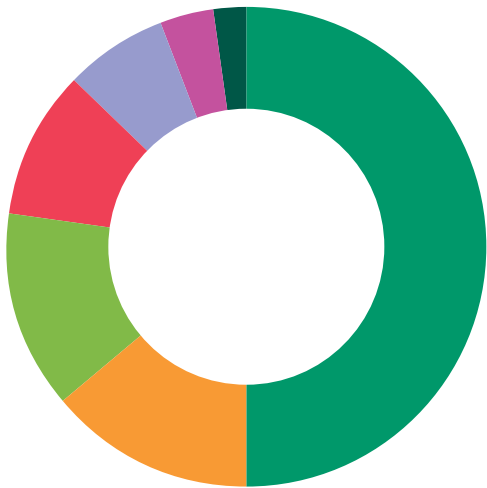

St. Mary's Ryken is a tax-exempt, 501(c)(3) organization. Contributions to SMR are 100 percent tax-deductible.

Cash Gifts

Most donors choose to make donations through a cash donation. SMR gratefully accepts cash and credit card donations. Gifts made via cash, check or credit card may entitle the donor to an income tax deduction in the year of the donation.

Income Interest Gifts

Through an income interest gift, a donor may contribute the income from an asset while retaining ownership of that asset. In this case, SMR receives income for a designated period of time, after which the asset and any subsequent income returns to the donor, the spouse, the children or other designees. This form of gift offers both immediate and future tax advantages.

Charitable Remainder Gifts

Through a remainder gift, a donor may contribute assets, such as securities or real estate, to SMR and retain for life the income from those assets for himself or herself, his or her spouse, or both. A remainder gift permits the donor to take an income tax deduction for the charitable portion of the gift. Furthermore, if the gift is in the form of appreciated securities or real estate, the donor does not pay capital gains taxes on the appreciation.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE AT ST. MARY'S RYKEN

Our academic excellence has been sustained by the commitment and vision of generous donors whose gifts have improved campus facilities, strengthened faculty and academic resources, and provided access for students, regardless of their financial backgrounds. There are many opportunities for you to make a difference at St. Mary's Ryken.

Securities

Gifts of securities/appreciated stock are perhaps the best form of assets to use in making a charitable gift. In most cases, an outright gift of appreciated securities entitles the donor to an income tax charitable deduction for the fair market value of the securities and, in the case of securities that have been held for more than 12 months, the avoidance of capital gains taxes.

Planned Giving and Legacy Opportunities

A planned gift is any major gift, made in lifetime or at death as part of a donor's overall financial and/or estate planning. Planned gifts enable philanthropists to make larger gifts to nonprofits than they could make from their income alone. While some planned gifts provide lifelong income to the donor, others use estate and tax planning techniques to provide for charity and other heirs in ways that maximize the gift and/or minimize its impact on the donor's estate.

Bequests

Donors may include a bequest to St. Mary's Ryken in their estate plans. Bequests may be for a specific amount, a percentage of the donor's estate, or even a residual portion. To make a bequest from your retirement account, IRA or other, simply ask for a beneficiary form from your accountant and complete the percent of that account you wish St. Mary's Ryken High School to receive. That portion is a deduction from the estate and may reduce your estate taxes.

Life Insurance Policies

An existing life insurance policy that is no longer needed by the donor can be given to SMR, or a new policy may designate the school as owner and beneficiary. In either case, the value of the existing policy (or the donor's investment, if less) or the donor's payments to cover annual premiums on a new policy are fully deductible as charitable contributions.

Current SMR Scholarship Funds

The Class of 1985 Scholarship Fund

Established in 2009 by the Class of 1985 — the first class to attend SMR all four years — to commemorate the 25th anniversary of their graduation. The scholarship is awarded to a student with a strong academic background and a demonstrated need for financial assistance.

The Joseph and Julia Bordell Scholarship Fund

Established by Bill and Lucille Reuter to honor the memory of Lucille's parents. They highly valued education, and both of their children were career educators. The scholarship is awarded based on academic achievement, service to the community and a need for financial assistance.

The Sean Brady Memorial Scholarship Fund

Established in 1992 by Thomas Brady and Eileen Valentine in memory of

their son, Sean, a member of the Class of 1992. Two awards are made annually; one scholarship is awarded to a current student with financial need, and a second to a graduating senior for college tuition.

The John T. Buffington Scholarship Fund

The James Dobry Scholarship Fund

Created by James in 2003 to provide financial assistance to students from St. Mary’s County. Awards are based on both academic merit and financial need.

The Bob Durbin Scholarship Fund

Established in 2011 by the alumni of Ryken High School and St. Mary’s Ryken to honor Bob Durbin, a beloved teacher, coach and mentor to many students for over 40 years. The scholarship is awarded to a student who demonstrates strong academic achievement, leadership skills, a strong desire to be involved in service and volunteer work, and a need for financial assistance.

The Kenneth B. Duke Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund

Established by family members to honor Kenneth, a 1939 graduate of St. Mary’s Academy. The fund provides financial assistance to two incoming freshmen.

The Margaret Powers Ellis Scholarship Fund

Established by the Hurlburt family in memory of Peggy Ellis to honor her lifelong commitment to Catholic education. Awards are given to students with strong academic backgrounds and a demonstrated need for financial assistance.

The William and Violet Fenwick Scholarship Fund

Dr. J. Patrick Jarboe, a 1951 graduate of St. Mary's Academy, dedicated his life

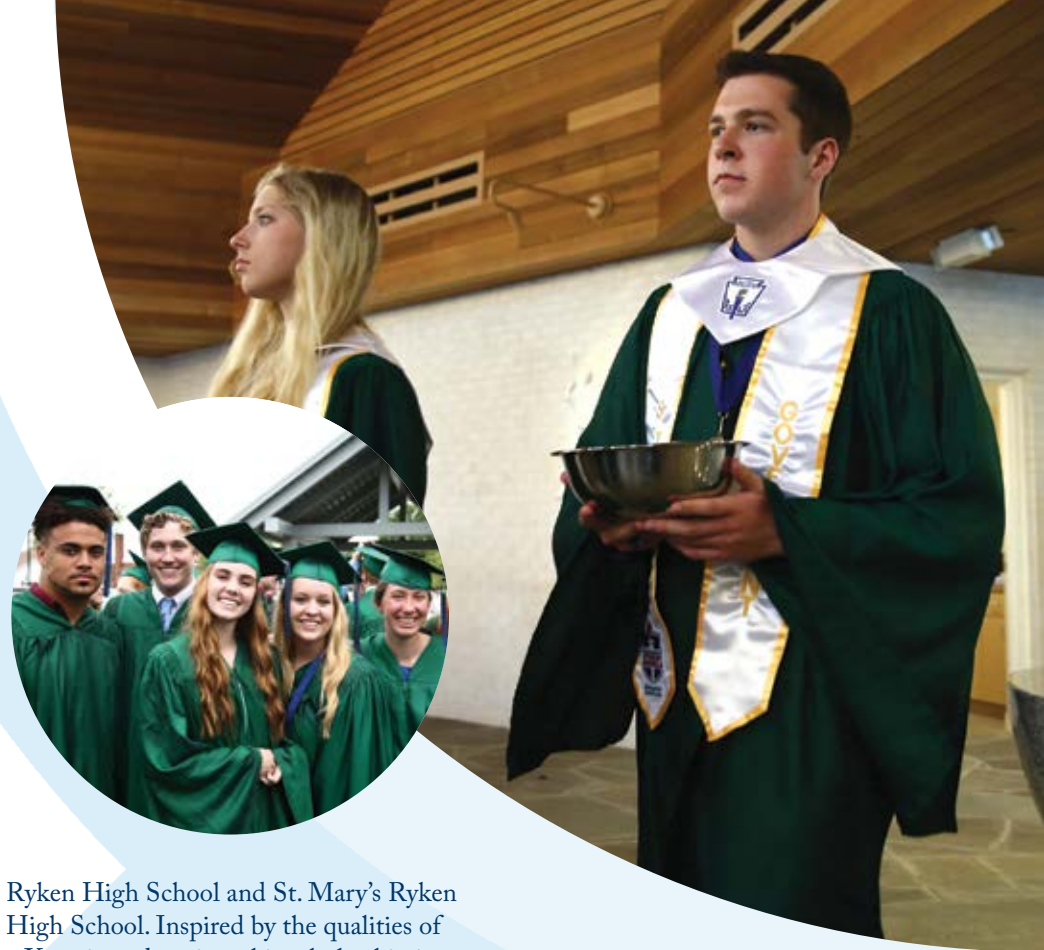

Kohlenbush Scholarship
