What May Be Exchanged or Donated?

Clothing to be exchanged or donated cannot have ink/marker/pencil marks, missing buttons, tears or other flaws. In addition, all items must be washed and neatly folded with no missing buttons, tears or any other flaws to the fabric.

The shop accepts only Pearland ISD dress code approved clothing.

Donations of lunch kits, backpacks and new or gently-worn shoes are also welcome.

Donations of NEW socks and underwear are also welcome.

What Is the Clothing Voucher?

A voucher allows families in need to get donated items without exchanging.

For clothing vouchers, contact your school nurse, counselor or principal. Vouchers must be signed in fresh ink. No copies are allowed.
