#### MISSION STATEMENT


Founded in 1962, the School's mission is to cultivate excellence through French-English bilingual and multicultural learning.

Students graduate with an American high school diploma, as well as either the French Baccalaureate or International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma. ISB is the only secondary school in New England to offer this opportunity.

## **DESCRIPTION OF UPPER SCHOOL**

The Upper School students follow a schedule that starts at 8:00am and ends anywhere between 3:30 and 5:30pm, according to course selection. Students in 9th and 10th grades follow a program tailored to prepare them for the requirements of either the French Baccalaureate or the IB diploma. In 11th grade, students determine which Baccalaureate program to pursue.

#### ISB offers the following, when possible:

#### **VARSITY:**

Boys' Soccer, Girls' Soccer, Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Boys' Volleyball, Girls' Volleyball, Co-ed Fencing

#### **CLUBS:**

Botany and Horticulture, Chess, Coding, EcoAction, Fencing, Finance, Diversity and Inclusion, Entrepreneurship, Student Council, Math, Model United Nations, ISB Radio, LifeArt,

Politics/Current Events, Film/Video, Astronomy, Yearbook, Rock Band, Guitar, Theater Company, Creative Writing, ASL, Spanish, Jewelry Making, German

Students are encouraged to create clubs or contribute to the school based on their talents and interests.

#### ISB partners with the following institutions:

- Massachusetts Institute of Technology: to provide summer internships in Math and participation in the BioBuilder Program
- Dornbirn High School, Austria: Exchange program for 9th and 10th graders
- **Dassault Systèmes:** to provide a 3D exploration and design course for 9th/10th graders in our Design Hub
- American International School in Barcelona: Academic exchange opportunity for students in Grade 10

#### FRENCH BACCALAUREATE

The French Ministry of Education recently reformed the twoyear French Baccalaureate curriculum. The revised French Baccalaureate is now comprised of common core classes, specialties, and electives. Each is given specific weight when calculating the final, overall Baccalaureate score. Exams which provide the final qualification score for each course are now given both throughout the year, as well as at the culmination of a course. Exam scores are then calculated together for a final score. ISB has a 100% pass rate for the French Bac.

#### **CORE COURSES FOR 11TH AND 12TH GRADE INCLUDE:**

Language A (English— could include BFI: see below), Language B (Spanish or German), French (completed in 11th grade), History/Geography (includes BFI; see below), Civic Education; Philosophy (grade 12/Terminale), Biology/Physics/Chemistry; Physical Education.

#### **SPECIALIZATIONS:**

In 11th grade, students choose three courses in which to specialize. Students choose three to complete in 11th grade; two continue into 12th grade. **Specializations are considered to be college- level courses.** ISB offers the following specializations: History/Geography/Political Science, Economics and Social Sciences, Mathematics (all students are required to choose Mathematics in 11th grade), Physics/Chemistry; Biology.

#### **ELECTIVES:**

Students may elect to study the following courses: Latin, Visual Arts (includes both theory and practice), Theater; Virtual Reality-3D Design, Mathematics elective (12th grade only), Mathematics Advanced (12th grade only)

# **BACCALAURÉAT FRANÇAIS INTERNATIONAL (BFI)**

The BFI American option (Baccalaureat Francais Internationale), a variation of the French Baccalaureate, takes into consideration the international dimension of education. It is the most demanding curriculum in the French Baccalaureate program and is offered only to students who master English both orally and in written expression. The literature and history/geography examinations carry significant weight in the calculation of the overall Baccalaureate score. The BFI option requires five

50-minute periods per week in both 11th and 12th grades for literature and History/Geography. Students must also take courses in contemporary issues (Connaissance du monde) to prepare them to be global citizens. They also complete a personal project (in partnership with an international organization) based on their interests; this culminates in an oral presentation. Students are selected for this program by committee review.

# **INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMA PROGRAM**

The International School of Boston was the first school in Boston to become a member of the International Baccalaureate Organization and to offer the IB Diploma Program. Taught in English at ISB, the IB is recognized worldwide and is highly valued for its depth and rigor. The aim of the IB program is to develop "internationally-minded people who, recognizing their common humanity and shared guardianship of the planet, help to create a better and more peaceful world." At ISB, 75% of IB students receive the IB Bilingual Diploma, by taking literature courses in two different languages. This specialized diploma is achieved by only 28% of IB students worldwide.

#### **IB DIPLOMA REOUIREMENTS:**

- Three Higher Level (HL) courses (five 50-minute periods/week) and three Standard Level (SL) courses (three 50-minute periods/week) covering six groups;
- Theory of Knowledge (ToK) course (two 50-minute periods/ week);
- Extended Essay, a 4000-word essay drawing on one of the six disciplines making up the IB program;
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), a community service requirement over two years, including the central element of student reflection.

The IB examinations take place over a three-week period in May of the senior year, involving 22–30 hours of testing. Students receive a score of 0–7 per course and may receive bonus points for their Extended Essay and assessments in Theory of Knowledge for a maximum of 45 points.
