

Sheldon ISD - Daycare On Demand Parent Information Sheet/Agreement

Please read prior to completing the student enrollment form. Completing the enrollment form means you agree with all guidelines and procedures listed below.

Overview:

Sheldon ISD is offering free child care for school age children of district employees starting August 24, 2020. These services are available for all school-aged children (ages 4-17) regardless of the district they will attend for the 2020-2021 school year. Child care will be housed at the campus where the employee works. If the employee does not work at one of the campuses, the student(s) will be assigned to their home campus. Students that attend schools outside of Sheldon ISD will be assigned to a campus based on availability. Enrollment will begin Monday, August 10 and close Friday, August 14, 2020. Confirmation of enrollment will be emailed by Wednesday, August 19, 2020. A parent information meeting will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 19, 2020.

Sheldon ISD - Daycare On Demand Guidelines and Procedures

1. The child care program is only available during school closures.
2. The ration of children per adult will be 6:1 for Pre-K-2 and 8:1 for 3-12th, if possible.
3. The program will practice all district's social distancing guidelines and procedures.
4. Parents may also submit a request to the campus principal for their child(ren) to remain in the employee's classroom to complete Sheldon On Demand schoolwork.
5. Hours of operation will follow the work schedule of the parent.
6. Students are expected to follow the Sheldon ISD Student Code of Conduct at all times. If there are disciplinary issues, the campus principal or designee will contact the parent.
7. Students are expected to follow the regular school day dress code.
8. Students will follow all CDC guidelines such as social distancing, hand washing/sanitizing, etc.
9. Parents are responsible for providing a face mask for students grades 3 and up.
10. Parents must provide school supplies as required for student use.
11. Lunch and snacks will be provided by the parent.
12. Each student should bring a "FUN KIT" with items to use during transitions and free time such as books, crayons, coloring books, word search puzzles, etc.
13. Each parent will sign an agreement before the student may attend the program.
14. We are utilizing the after-school program staff to support a Jump Start Camp August 24 - September 4, 2020. (Prior to the start of school)

15. Starting September 8, 2020, students will follow the Sheldon On Demand schedule with support from the supervising staff.
