Design tests, assignments, reports, performances, or other activities that measure the types and quality of learning expected.

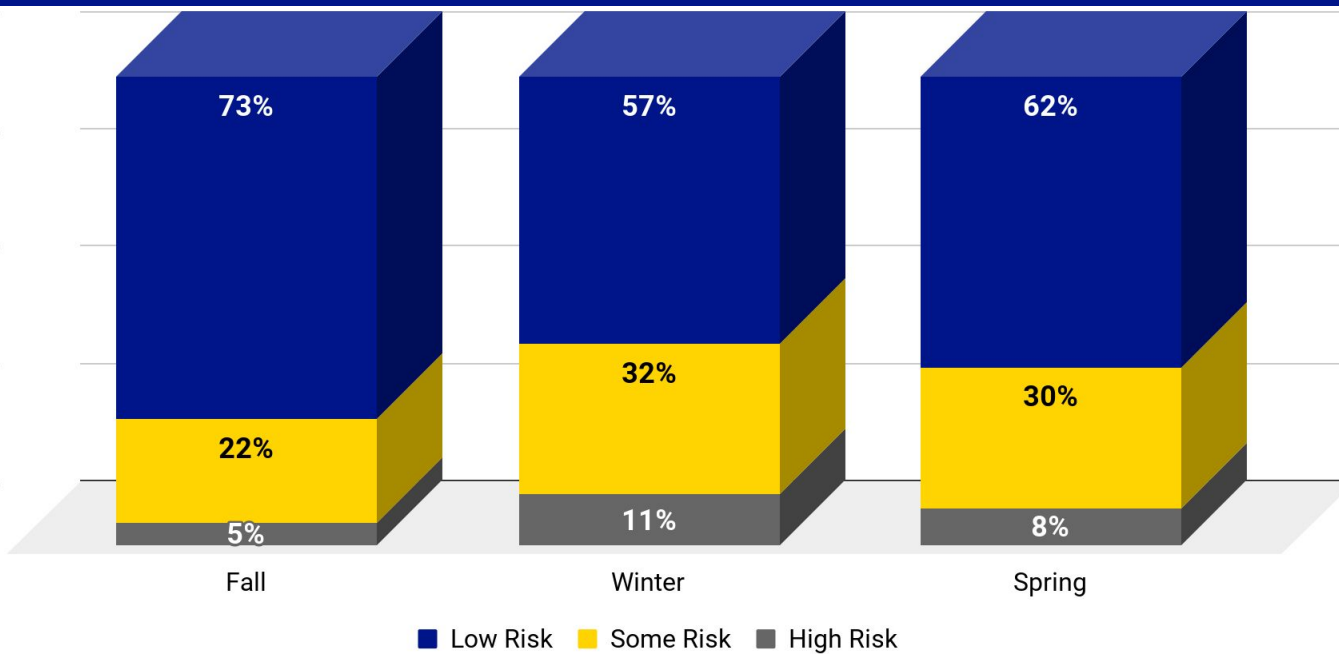
Review Findings

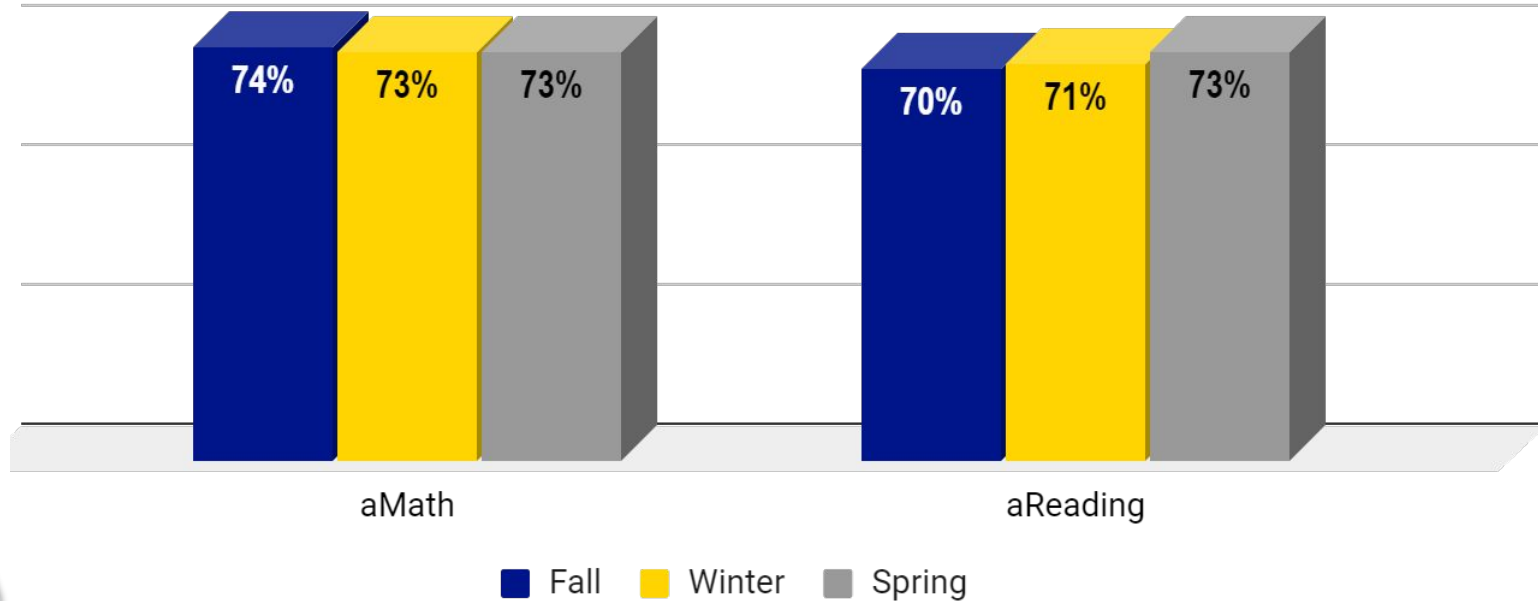

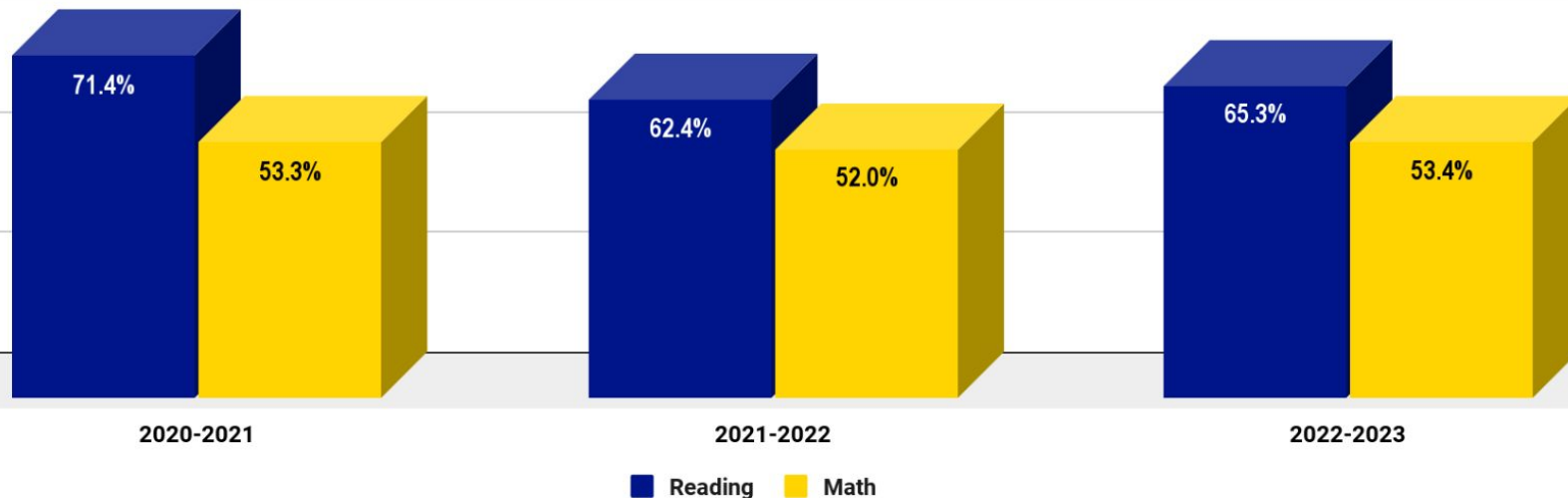

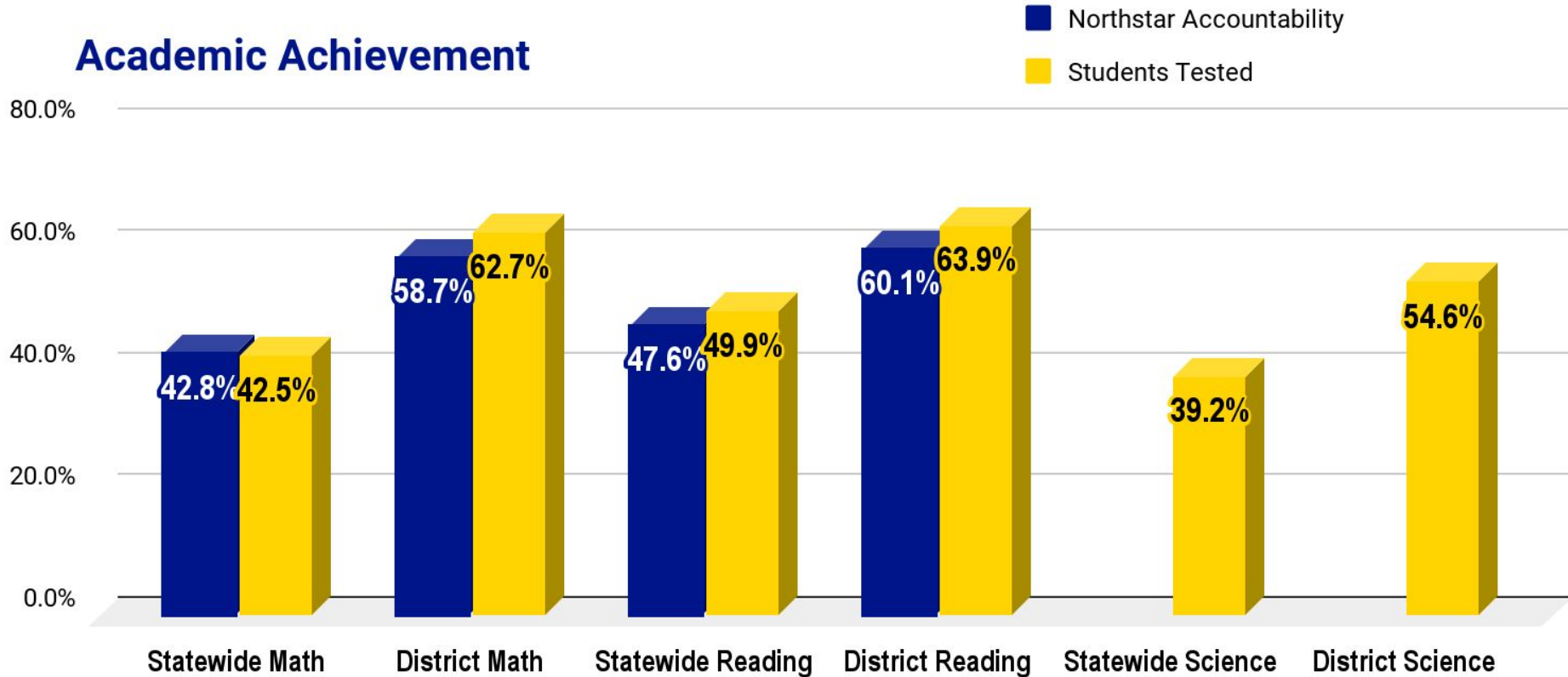
Percent of Students Meeting Benchmark



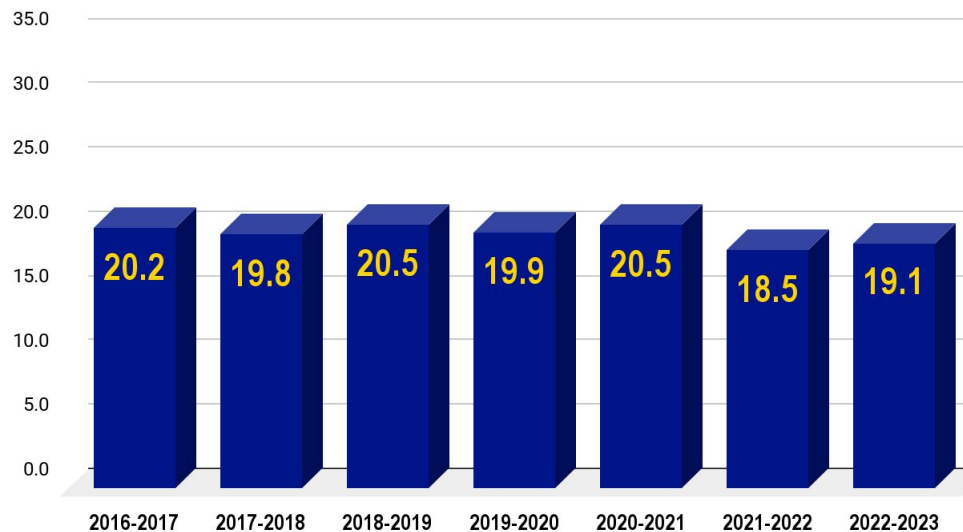
MAP Results (Grades 5-8)



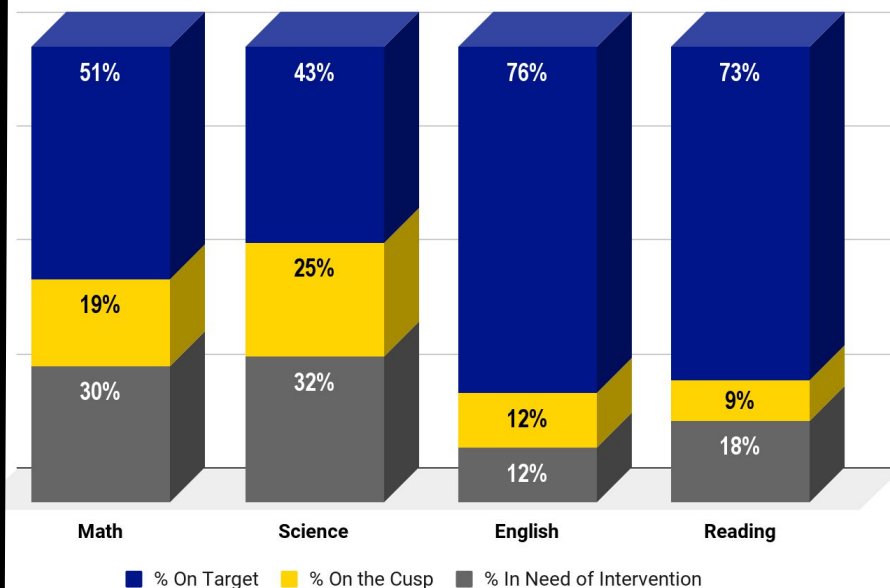
Academic Achievement



Average Composite Score

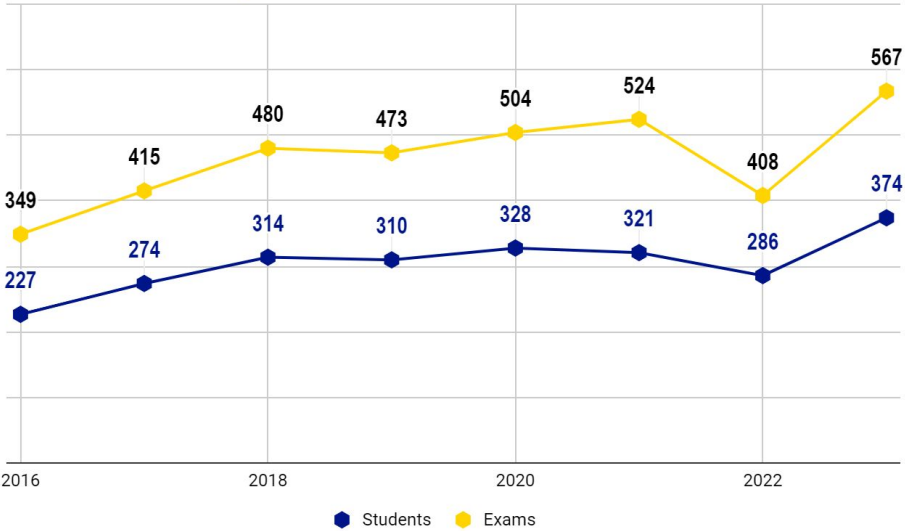


PreACT: Subject Performance

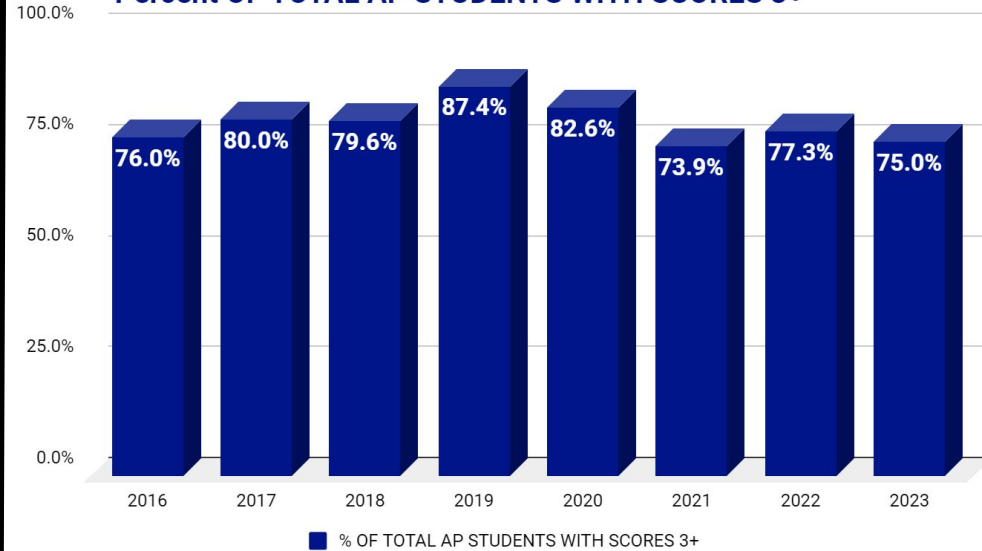


Advanced Placement (AP)

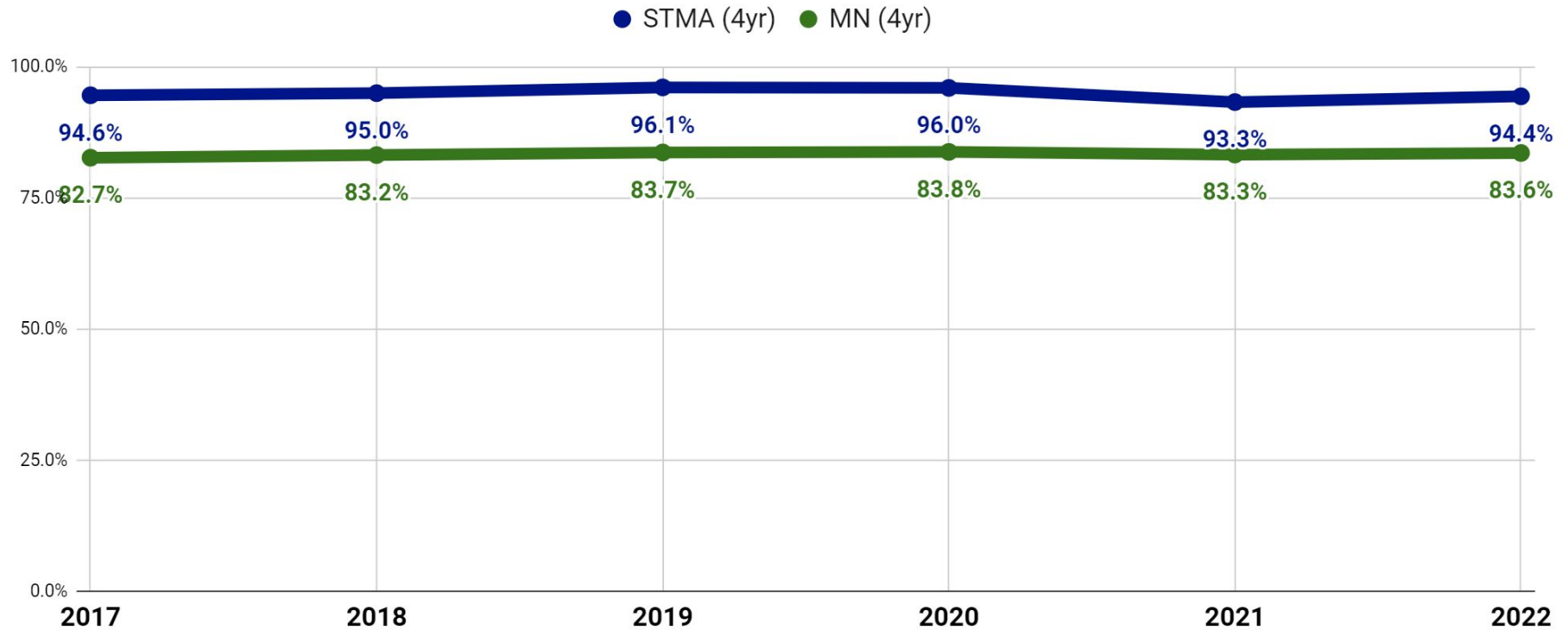
AP Exam Participation
