### **Heather with the PTA report:**

- The fundraiser finishes tomorrow, current count at 6k.
- School Social, mostly positive feedback.
  - Some students and teachers complained the music was too loud. Request the DJ to reduce the volume for the next event.
  - Approx. 60 students who had tardies and about 40 students elected not to join.

### **Anna with the SAC Report:**

- We are on track with all of our goals.
- From SIC, requesting SCC to modify the dress code regarding hoodies to: Children can wear hoodies but not the hood.
  - From a survey of the teachers, 50% of the teachers responded to adding the modification to the dress code, 25% said they have no opinion and 25% said they do not wish to change the dress code.
  - The 50% of teachers who would like the change say they feel fatigued by trying to enforce rules of their room.
  - Policy S5 requires SCC must provide a space for discussion and then 3 more meetings that include the public. Include the dress code modification to the agenda for the next meeting.
