- Remediation is recommended for all D's and F's.



# STANDARDIZED TESTING



SAT Day: The San Jose Unified School District's mission is to eliminate the opportunity gap and provide every student with the finest 21st century education. As of 2016, SJUSD provides the SAT Exam free of charge to all Juniors students each year.

ACT/SAT exams: WGHS does not report SAT/ACT scores on school transcripts. From the class of 2018: 369 seniors took the SAT; the school SAT average score was 1026, higher than the district average, 1014.

AP Exams: 481 students took a total of 888 AP Examinations in 2018. 66% of the total AP Students passed with a score of 3 or higher compared to the 60% global rate. We also had 50 AP Scholars, including those with Honor (23), with Distinction (42), and National Scholars (11).

--Project Lead the Way (PLTW), Biomedical Sciences Program: A three-course curriculum focusing on human medicine. All PLTW Courses are considered to be Honors level courses. Course sequence as follows: 1. Principles of Biomedical Sciences, 2. Human Body Systems, 3. Medical Interventions

-- Engineering Science Technology Course: Students are prepared for the technological world; Studying Mechanical fluid, electrical and thermal systems, primarily, through hands-on student labs.

--Computer Science: Courses allow students to explore technology field careers in the computer engineering and technology industries.

--Silicon Valley Career Technical Education (SVCTE): 24 courses are available for WGHS students; 15 are STEM focused courses; 18 courses are A-G approved.
