

State Tuition Assistance Federal Tuition Assistance

- Eligible Upon Enlistment
- Up to \$274 per Credit Hour (MIZZOU'S RATE)
- 39 Credits per year
- 15 credit hours per semester
- 9 credit hours per summer
- Pays for completion of Bachelors degree



- Eligible AFTER completion of AIT
- Up to \$250 per Credit Hour
- Maximum of \$4,000 per School Year







Montgomery G.I. Bill + Kicker

- Eligible Upon Completion of AIT
- \$392 per Month
- Additional \$350 Kicker
- Tax Free Money





•National Guard Soldiers reside within their State.

•Every State has a National Guard.

•Army and the Air Force only.

•Receive State Benefits as well as all Federal Benefits.

•Members attend training and return home using education benefits.

Military Contracts

- **ALL** initial military contracts are 8 years long.
 - 3X5, 4X4, 6X2, 8x0.
- IRR...what is it? Why?
- Contract start dates will differ with each component.
 IMPORTANT notes: Active contracts start the day you ship, changes can be made when a soldier enters into a Delayed Entry Program to jobs and ship dates.

THE GUARD CAN HELP SUPPORT YOUR COLLEGE EDUCATION

Serve in the National Guard while pursuing a college education.

 The Guard offers assistance programs to help pay tuition costs and other educational expenses.





State Tuition Assistance:

39 Credits a year (15 Fall, 15 Spring, 9 summer) up to the cost per credit hour as University of Missouri--Columbia

***Up to \$274.00 per semester hour.

Army/Air National Guard Only!

Federal Tuition Assistance:

Pays up to \$250.00 for 16 Semester Hours/Year 1 October-30 September.

Montgomery G.I. Bill Chapter 1606:

Incentive to attend Post Secondary; Trade School; or job training. \$392.00/month.

GI Bill Kicker \$350.00/month***

Founded in 1636 as a citizen force organized to protect families and towns from hostile attacks, today's National Guard Soldiers hold civilian jobs or attend college while maintaining their military training part time, always ready to defend the American way of life in the event of an emergency.

Our Mission.

National Guard Soldiers serve both community and country. Our versatility enables us to respond to domestic emergencies, overseas combat missions, counterdrug efforts, reconstruction missions and more. The Guard always responds with speed, strength and efficiency, helping to defend American freedom and ideals.

Our Citizen-Soldiers.

As a Guard Soldier, your primary area of operation is your home state. Any governor or the president himself can call on the Guard at a moment's notice. Typically, Guard Soldiers live at home, where they can be near friends and family while holding a civilian job. Drill is scheduled just one weekend each month. Two-week Annual Training takes place once each year.
