

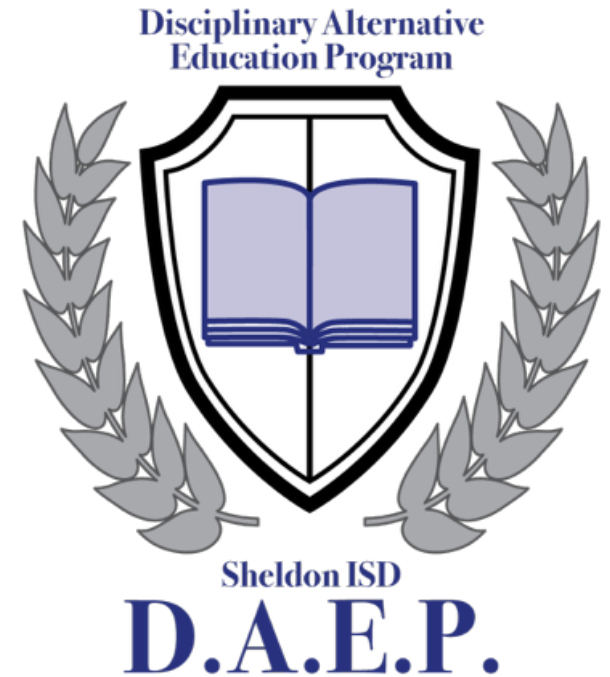
ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

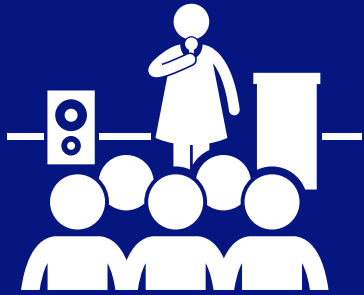

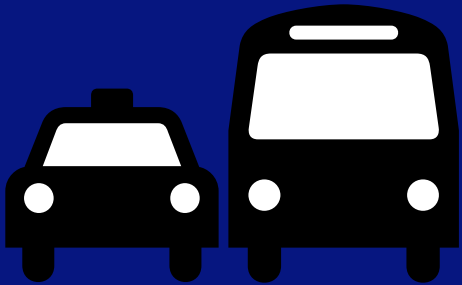

ORIENTATION

An individual intake meeting must be held with the legal guardian and the student. During this meeting, Parents are required to schedule this meeting with Intake Specialist. During this meeting, the DAEP procedures and expectation are explained.



TRANSPORTATION

Sheldon ISD does not provide transportation to and or from DAEP. Parents are required to arrange transportation for students but students are not allowed to drive themselves.

COURSEWORK



Students will receive core content through the Edgenuity platform and electives through Google Classroom. Grades will be submitted to the home campus on a weekly basis.

DRESS CODE

The purpose of the dress code is to create a conformity and high achieving expectations. Students should wear the following:

- **Shirt** - Solid white, long/short sleeved, button-down dress shirt or polo
- **Pants** - Appropriately fitted khaki colored pants only.
- **Belt** - Solid plain black /brown belt
- **Shoes** - Solid black closed-toe shoes (No Crocs or slides)
- **Accessories** - No accessories allowed, including body jewelry, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, and watches.
