#### SCHEDULED EVACUATION DRILL

As part of Wood Dale School District 7's commitment to keep students safe, Oakbrook staff and students will walk to the Woodlands at White Oaks to practice an off school grounds evacuation in case of an emergency. Upon arriving to the Woodlands, staff and students will immediately return to school to resume their regular school day. The practice evacuation will start at 1:30 PM on **Monday, October 2,** depending on the weather. Please make sure your children are appropriately dressed for the day which will include a short walk to and from the remote location.



#### INTRUDER LOCK DOWN DRILL

On Wednesday, **October 11** starting at **1:30 pm**, Oakbrook will conduct a required PRACTICE lockdown with the presence of a police officer. Students will be calmly guided by their teacher

to remain in their classrooms and quietly hide. Children will be safe and there will be no reason for concern. Teachers will work to prepare students ahead of the PRACTICE event.

#### PATIENCE WITH DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Thank you for your patience as we update our dismissal procedures. We are trying to maintain a balance of student safety with reasonable parent pick-up times. Our goal is to begin dismissing groups of students at 3:27pm on regular school days and 2:52pm on early dismissal days. If you come for pick up and the #3 doors are already closed, please come to door #1 to pick up your child. You will need to ring the bell to call the office, and we will bring your child to you at door #1.



HOW TO ADD A LABEL TO GOOGLE PHOTO


- 1. Click on the selected photo

#### **POLICE OFFICER SCHOOL VISITS**

These past two weeks, Officer Werner, our School Resource Officer, co-hosted student safety assemblies. The following topics were discussed:

- -Trusted adults
- -What is an emergency

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-Appropriate words and actions in school

Specifically, students were made aware that they may not threaten students using the words **kill**, **gun**, **knife**, or related terms.

If a student threatens to harm a student and uses the words **kill**, **gun**, **knife**, or related terms, an investigation will be conducted, and a record of the results will be placed in the student's file.

#### PLEASE KEEP TOYS AT HOME

Reminder, students' toys should remain at home. Not only do toys at school create distraction from learning, students get very upset when their toys are lost. The school is unable to perform investigations regarding lost toys. Thank you for your understanding and support on this matter.
