

*The following is geared towards college-/university-bound students.

FALL:

- ✓ If you haven't already, create a master calendar of application launch dates - some will be open already (you should also note college application, scholarship application, housing, and financial deadlines). Please consider applying to 5-7 colleges/universities.
- ✓ Continue to look for scholarships (Ms. Muir will post scholarship
 opportunities periodically on Class of 2024 Teams).
- Make the last of your college visits (remember, there are virtual visits available via the schools' websites!)
- ✓ Last chance to take the SAT, if needed (most schools no longer require the SAT so be sure to check each school's application requirements).
- Apply (college applications, financial aid, and housing applications). To maximize chances of in-house scholarships, apply when applications launch (not by the deadline date). If you qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch, you may qualify for application fee waivers.
- ✓ Verify that your high school transcripts are correct and up-to-date.
