

A challenge she decided to take on was the overwhelming need to rescue animals in NC, which unfortunately ranks 3rd in the nation for the number of cats and dogs euthanized each vear. She started this program after the loss of her beloved cat Bosko and now RescueConnect finds fosters and forever homes for animals along the NC eastern coast. Ava stated her work is a "labor of love with a big return on investment" and we can do our part by spaying and neutering our pets!
