Moreau Catholic has a student population of about 825 students and is located on 14 acres. Moreau Catholic is committed to outstanding achievement and prepares students through academic, social and spiritual learning experiences that form and transform our students as they become responsible citizens of our global community.

Welcome!

We thank you for your interest in Moreau Catholic High School's International Student Program (ISP). Our program is designed to accommodate full-time, diploma-seeking international students currently living and studying in their home country, and who have an interest in studying at and graduating from Moreau Catholic High School. We accept applications for students entering 9th, 10th and 11th grades. Our international students are immersed in our English-speaking community and learn from academic, social, and spiritual experiences.

At this time, Moreau Catholic High School requires all new international students to enroll in our English for International Students course for their first year. This course is designed to assist with the student's transition into our academic program. In addition, upon arrival to the school, each student will be assessed in English to ensure the appropriate course placement and support.

Qualified international students are encouraged to submit their applications and all supporting documents as soon as possible. We have a rolling admissions process for international applicants, pending space availability. The sooner students apply and complete the process, the sooner they will have an admission decision from the Office of Admissions.

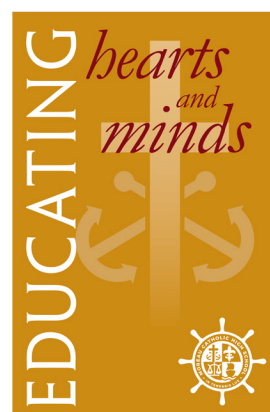

IDEAL LOCATION AND SAFETY

Located in the heart of the San Francisco Bay Area, Moreau Catholic High School is a 14 acre campus, which is gated with only one main entrance. We have secured entrances to all buildings, and visitors must register with our staff when checking in through our front lobby. We have experienced, full-time security personnel to monitor our facilities during the school day and on-campus events. TUITION & COSTS

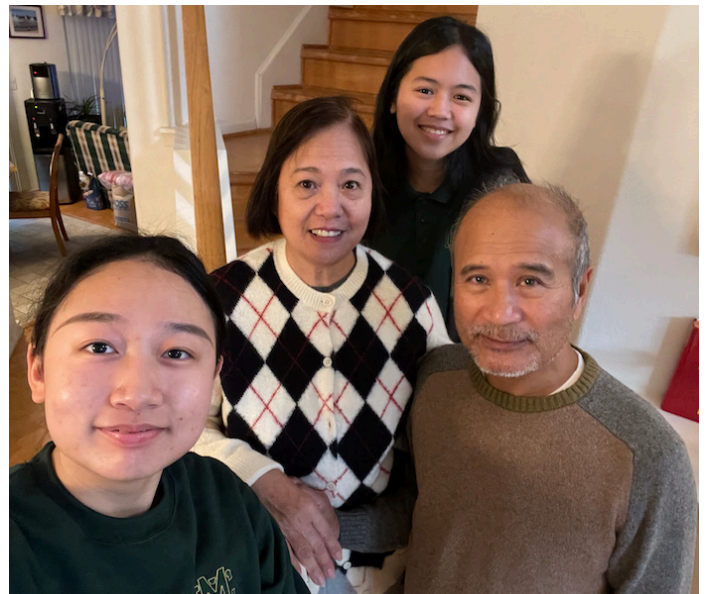
Tuition for Moreau Catholic's International Student Program for the 2023-2024 school year is \$35,430.

Included in tuition is the following:

- A full schedule of college preparatory classes, which may include Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses
- A designated Counselor who provides academic support and advocacy for students
- Personalized college advising to support students in successfully navigating the application, admissions, and scholarship process for American and international universities
- A year-long UC-approved English course with academic and English language support
- A required summer orientation with
 - Multiple workshops
 - Cultural exchange with American students
 - A field trip to a local university or bay area attraction
 - An orientation to the school including a review of school expectations and staff introductions
- Moreau Catholic's Link Crew Team designated to mentor international students in academic and social activities on and off campus throughout the year
- An Apple MacBook laptop, textbooks, reading books, a yearbook, 2 locks for lockers, school uniform and Physical Education uniform
- Leadership and participation opportunities in a wide variety of academics, athletics, and arts
- Celebration of cultural holidays

HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS

Moreau Catholic High School does not offer on-campus housing or boarding accommodations. Currently, all international students requiring a student visa to attend Moreau Catholic High School are **required** to be contracted with one of our local international agencies. These agencies provide necessary support and guidance while the student is attending Moreau Catholic High School. Our host families are expected to provide transportation, nutritious meals, and the student's own bedroom. Information regarding our partner agencies will be provided to all newly enrolled international students.

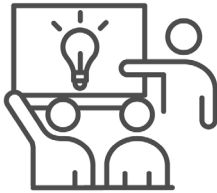
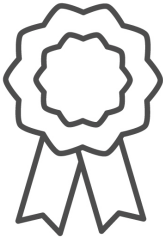

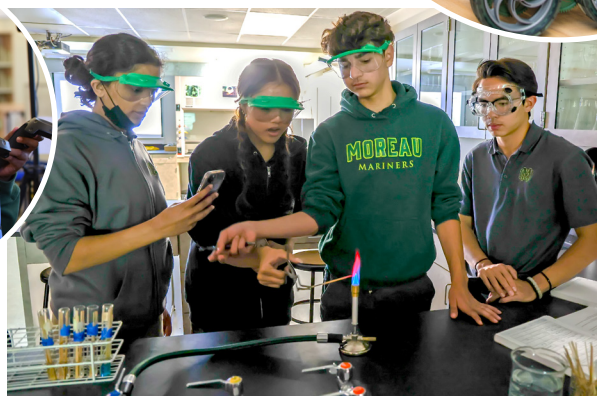
STEM: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math

Students develop critical thinking and observational skills in our state-of-the-art STEM spaces. They learn to gather and interpret data, communicate results clearly and effectively, and apply concepts to real world scenarios.

In Robotics, students confront tasks and challenges with principles covered in their math and science classes. They learn to apply computer programming skills to make their robots respond and then they analyze the results.

Innovation & Technology

Design Studio

Mariners are leaders of the next generation of innovators, learning to change the world in unique and dynamic ways. They are risk takers and inventors, creating processes and designing projects that will contribute to making our world a better place.

Bioprinting

Moreau Catholic offers students the opportunity through educational 3D bioprinting to develop and apply code to print proteins, cells, and DNA with innovative, educational applications for biotechnology, bioengineering, and green engineering. This educational 3D technology is revolutionizing the professional industry in the areas of tissue engineering, organ production, and medical device development.

Film and Video Production

Moreau Catholic TV (MCTV) is the only Bay Area high school fully equipped TV Production Studio. Students film their own live, weekly news broadcasts and are instructed in lighting, sound, scriptwriting, editing, and the art of communication.

Advanced Placement Tests

All students who are enrolled in Advanced Placement classes are required to take the AP exam for the class or classes in which they are enrolled. In May 2022, 259 students took a total of 666 Advanced Placement exams. The pass rate was 61% for A.P. examinations. In May, 2023, 302 students plan to take 695 examinations in the following areas:

How to Apply

Each applicant is required to submit the following:

- Online Admission Application with application fee of \$95.00 USD
- Current English Teacher Recommendation Form
- Current Math Teacher Recommendation Form
- Current Principal or School Counselor Recommendation Form
- Official English Translation of Academic Records - Your official academic records or transcript, which includes academic progress for the last two years.
- Standardized Test Results: TOEFL, TOEFL Jr., IELTS, or iTEP Slate. Duolingo will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
Please note: TOEFL Jr. is not accepted for Grade 10 and 11 applicants
- Campus Visit or Skype/Zoom Interview - The Office of Admissions will contact the applicant directly, once we have received their application.
- Copy of Student's Passport
- Financial Statement—Submit a copy of your current bank statement showing you have sufficient funds to pay tuition for the 2023-2024 school year.
