### Arts & Science

#### Around the World in 5 Days K - 2nd \$179 June 12-16

Kids will do craft activities to learn about a new country. We will do outdoor games/sports that originated or are prevalent in that country. We will have a Field Day on Thursday to show off our arts and crafts and throw a celebration typical to this country. This will be a fun, full-of-activities camp that sparks children's curiosity to learn about different cultures and to explore the world. Each child will receive a passport that will be stamped each day as they "visit" a new country.
