Three Crockett County sports teams recorded victories Tuesday and a couple of others suffered defeats as the fall seasons continued for Cavalier athletics.

Fresh off bringing Coach Bobby Rawson his record-setting 665th career win Monday night, the Lady Cav volleyballers kept things rolling with a 3-0 straight-set road triumph at South Gibson in Medina, boosting their season mark to 21-5. Crockett will carry that record into Saturday's Crockett Invitational, where it will take on Trenton, Scotts Hill, and Gibson County in matches scheduled for 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 1:30 p.m. Quarterfinal play will then begin at 3:30.

Another team riding a win streak is the CCMS softball squad, which blitzed Martin 12-0 Tuesday for its 10th consecutive victory. Emmalynn Medlin pitched another one-hit shutout for the Lady Cavs, striking out nine against four walks, and also drove in three runs with a pair of hits. Outfielder Fallon Beard belted a home run for the winners and also had two hits and three RBIs. Catcher Macie Teel collected three hits and third baseman Madison Stitts knocked in two runs. Crockett is now 13-2.

The CCHS girls soccer team discovered again that the road to tournament advancement has to go through Dyersburg after the host Lady Trojans blanked the Crockett kickers 6-0 Tuesday. The Lady Cavs dropped to 6-4-1 for the year with the loss.

Coach Tyler Gadlen's CCMS football team defeated Trenton Tuesday night and has earned a berth in its conference championship game, set for September 26.
