

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS

As required by the Colorado Department of Health and Human Services, children must have a health/physical exam by a medical provider prior to every year attending preschool, and parents/guardians shall be encouraged to have a health/physical exam for their children prior to Kindergarten, and prior to the third, sixth and tenth grades. In addition, parents/guardians are encouraged to have a health/physical exam for students new to District 11 schools and those in any other grade who have health concerns.

Students who want to participate in Middle and High school athletics/sports must complete a physical annually. Athletic physical examination forms shall be furnished by Colorado Springs School District 11.
