Security Specialists have attended numerous trainings to ready specialists to carry firearms	
Implementation of specialists carrying firearms is after winter break	
CFB meets or exceeds nearby law enforcement requirements, including drug screens, background checks, etc.

Currently using Raptor on visitor entry, including CFB staff - those people will be accounted for through the Raptor system

With any new technology, there will be bumps in the road, so we're looking for progress, not perfection	
Some ESDC staff who spend a lot of time on campuses will need to be rostered to those campuses	
All Raptor campus trainings have been scheduled. It will be recorded so staff who were not present can still watch.	
Once campus trained, Raptor will be used to conduct drills and for real incidents	
Campus admin sets the tone regarding use of Raptor

Drills will slow down because accounting for students, staff, and guests	
When Team Assists are activated, admin will need to close them
