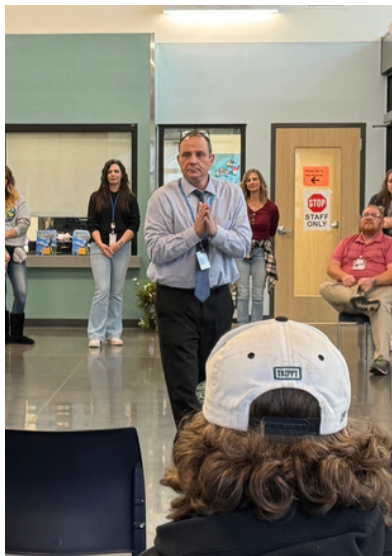

MASON BEE NESTS

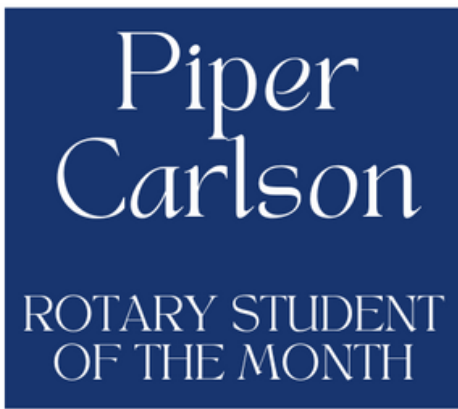


Volunteers joined second-grade students at Columbia City Elementary to help them clean their Mason Bee nests.
