

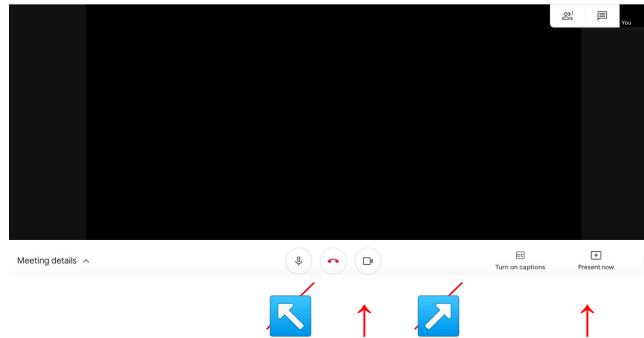

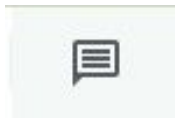


**Microphone**: click to **mute and unmute**, **Phone**: click to **hang up & end call**, **Video**: click to **show or hide your picture**.
