2024-2025 ACADEMIC CALENDAR APPROVED

The Buckeye Valley Local Schools Board of Education has approved a school calendar for the 2024-2025 school year that continues its commitment to academic excellence, while also continuing to support the growth and professional development of our teachers and staff.

The final board-approved calendar was developed using input from staff and administration. It includes a two-week Christmas/New Year break in December and a spring break that is aligned with other Delaware County Schools in March. These are both aspects that the district feels are important for our BV Community.

New for the 2024-25 school year, will be a week-long Fall break that is aligned with the Delaware County Fair, September 16- September 20, 2024. An additional change is the elimination of the four two-hour delays for professional development. Traditionally, student absences during the Delaware County Fair week are higher than at any other time of the school year. The newly approved calendar will provide students and families time to participate in this community event without missing instructional time.

Superintendent, Paul Craft stated, "This calendar takes the needs of our students, staff, and families into consideration by reconfiguring our Staff Professional Days and aligning breaks to community events and holidays. This calendar should support the work of the District of focusing on high-quality teaching and learning."

The first day of the 2024-25 school year for students will be Wednesday, August 13, while the last day of school for students will be Thursday, May 29, 2025. We encourage all families to please consider planning vacations or family trips during one of the District's extended breaks.

In summary, the approved 2024-25 school year calendar features:

- 176 days of instruction.
- Professional workdays for teachers and staff to ensure the most highly qualified instructional staff are serving our students and to allow staff time to close out each quarter.
- Elimination of the 2-Hour Delayed Start days for Staff Professional Development.
- Full Week off during the Delaware County Fair so students and families can participate in this community event.
- A two-week Christmas/New Year break in December.
- A break in March that is aligned with all other Delaware County Schools.
- The last student day of school is in May.

GUIDELINES/REQUIREMENTS

- Families must reside in Delaware County.
- Children 12 and younger qualify to participate.
- Applications will be reviewed/approved on a firstcome basis.

Once we're full, we will no longer accept new applications; but we will attempt to connect families with other community resources through HelpLine.

- First-time applicants will take precedent over families who participated last year.
- Families participating in People in Need's 2023
 Holiday Clearinghouse will NOT qualify for Shop
 with a Cop.
- Families will be notified by e-mail on Nov. 17th as to whether or not their child(ren) have been accepted.

Shopping date will be assigned by the Sheriff's Office and will occur on either Saturday morning, Dec. 2nd or Sunday Morning, Dec. 3rd. Reminder: The deadline to apply is Nov. 10th.
