- 1. The Receipt Listing Report and the Budget Summary Report were reviewed.
- 2. The High School Activity account was reviewed.
- 3. The Enrollment Report was reviewed, with the current number being 513.
- **4.** Athletic/Activities Report by Mr. Myhre: Spring sports have officially started! Softball and Track started this week and Baseball and Golf will start next week! The fields are dry and the new field is coming together nicely. We held the winter sports awards night last week. It is not as attended as well as the fall sports awards night. The youth sports have been very successful this season! The youth wrestling team qualified for the state tournament last weekend!
- 5. K-12 Principal/Community Ed Report by Mr. Frie: We will be offering a weight lifting class for girls this summer with Kaley Buysse and Brad Gillingham this summer. We are offering a Volleyball Camp and also Basketball Camps. We are looking at taking a charter bus to a Twins game with Lakeview this summer. The youth basketball teams did very well this season! The 6th grade girls ended up 58-7. The teaching staff attended the SW/WC Tech Conference yesterday. Mr. Frie attended a conference on Robotics in the Elementary and would like to implement it in our elementary. The 3rd quarter is over and we are in the final stretch! 22 students are failing a class, which is 7.8% of our students. 92.2% of our students are passing all of their classes! Mrs. Mahan-Deitte formed a leadership team to isolate the kids that are failing and we will be aggressive with those students to improve their grades and get them extra help. We will be having a one act play directed by Ms. Gades. It will be held May 13th & 14th. We are very appreciative of Ms. Gades taking this on! We have been busy moving offices and classrooms to get ready for the project. Mr.

- Frie would like to recognize the Speech Team, Robotics Team, and Knowledge Bowl Team! They are all growing and have great leaders!
- 6. Superintendents Report by Mr. Deitte: We are going to be starting a program called instructional coaching. Two of our teachers will go to MRVED this spring to learn the program and we will pilot the program next year. We are looking at practice test results with each teacher and the teacher and Mr. Frie is sitting down with each student to set goals on the final test. Thank you to Lois, Wade, and the custodians for making the computer lab switch happen so fast. Congratulations to the Robotics, Speech, Wrestling, and Basketball Teams on successful seasons. We had 6 individuals place at the state tournament, with one state champion! We attended the Tech Conference yesterday in Redwood Falls through the SW/WC Service Cooperative. Mr. Deitte ordered the playground material. We will be able to have about \$39,000 of the concession stand expenses covered under health and safety. We will receive our health insurance rates for next year on April 5th.
