

- Apply to School and Program
- Complete FAFSA/CASFA
- Evaluate Financial Aid Offer
- Register for Classes and Commit in May



## TREP

**Who:** D11 Graduates who Plan to be Educators or Counselors

**What:** Teacher Recruitment Education and Preparation program, 2 Years of Tuition

**When:** Fall Semester after D11 Graduation

**Where:** PPSC, UCCS, CSU-Pueblo

- Take 1 Education Course during Senior Year
- Apply to School and Program
- Complete FAFSA/CASFA
- Evaluate Financial Aid Offer
- Register for Classes and Commit in April
