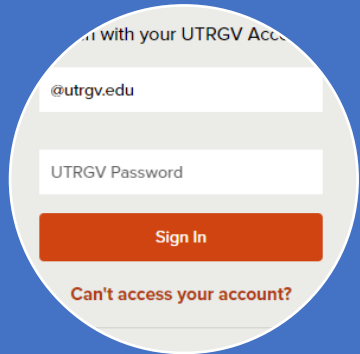

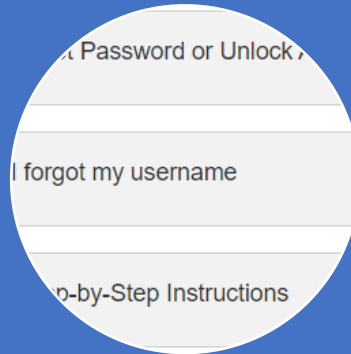
UTRGV™ Dual Credit Program

Examples of Academic Dishonesty

Results of cheating, plagiarism, unauthorized collaboration, and other forms of academic dishonesty may lead to **possible suspension or expulsion** from the university.

- Searching questions/prompts directly from quizzes, tests, exams, and essays using web browsers such as Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Firefox, Yahoo, Bing, etc. is a form of cheating.
- Submitting assignment without proper citations of references is a form of plagiarism.
- Sharing links, presentations, documents, and images of academic content with others via networking chats such as WhatsApp, GroupMe, Band, etc. is a form of unauthorized collaboration.

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy ACT (FERPA) 20 USC §1232g, and the Texas Public Information Act, Texas Government Code §552.001 et seq are respectively a federal and state law that prohibits the Student Services Centers (in person or over the phone) from releasing any specific education information. Parents, guardians, spouses, etc. cannot have access to the student's educational records, including account information.

- I. CampusShield is a free application design to facilitate the needs of students during emergency situations.
- II. CampusShield provides on campus resources that will direct you to services offered at UTRGV such as:
 - Counseling Center
 - Health Services
 - Victim Services
- III. CampusShield mobile app is available for students to download on Google Play or Apple App Store.


APP FEATURES

Emergency Button – Sends accurate location information to the phone number you designate using geo-fences.




 **Anonymous Report** – Report safety concerns, suspicious activities and crime tips. Also, can be used to text an emergency when calling is not ideal. Use photos / videos and report anonymously.

 **FriendWatch** – If your pre-set timer hits 0:00, your emergency contacts are notified. Friends and family members can watch out for each other during potentially dangerous activities.

 **Campus Resources** – Access important documents, procedures, calendars, etc. all in one place. Ensures everyone has updated information. Saves time and money on print outs.

 **Safe Walk** – Request a safety escort or contact a non-emergency phone number.

 **Campus Maps** – Access campus maps.

 **Bus Schedule** – Keep track of local bus schedules.

- Financial Aid requires Satisfactory Academic Progress

How can I get my transcript?

- To request an official transcript, the online ordering service must be used. \$5.00 fee.
- Unofficial transcripts are available to current UTRGV students through ASSIST.
