Dear DPS Families,

Our DPS Halloween Parade will be on Tuesday, October 31st at 1:30pm. Hopefully it will not be rainy, so we can parade outside. Families will stand in the bus loop as students parade down the sidewalk from DPS to EBH and then back to DPS. **Please stay in your viewing location until the parade is over and ALL students have entered DPS.** (If the weather is rainy we will have the parade inside DPS.)

3PK-PM and 4PK families, your child will make a costume at school for the parade. Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade families, when thinking about a costume, please remember the costume will be worn all day or must go over the top of your child's clothes. Costume masks will only be permitted during the parade. No costume weapons are allowed.

After the parade your child can stay at school for regular dismissal or be signed out. If you plan to sign out your child right after the parade:

**Please return the bottom of this slip to your child's classroom teacher and identify any approved people that can sign out your child. The pick up person will need to bring identification.*

Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival

All **4PK-2nd grade students** will enter at the main entrance of school and must be to school by 8:00.

- Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8:10.
- Buses unload students at 7:40.

All 3PK students will enter at the side door at 9:00 for the AM program or 12:30 for the PM program.

Dismissal

Dismissal changes must be made **before 1:00pm**. Parent pick-up will begin at 2:15pm each day at the following doors based on last name. Please make sure we have the name of the person picking up and that person has a ***driver's license for identification***.

- A-C at the ELC doorway on the parking lot side
- D-H at the back playground door
- I-Q at the first door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS
- R-Z at the second door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS

All 3PK AM and PM students will exit at the side door at 11:30 for the AM program and 3:00 for the PM program. Our 3PK students are dropped off and picked up in the small Primary Bus Loop during the following times: 8:45-9:00, 11:20-11:35, 12:20-12:30, and 2:50-3:05. Please consider parking in a different location so that you aren't trapped in the loop.
