Dear Families,

On **Thursday, June 15th** we have our DPS Leadership Morning Meeting with families included from **8:30-9:30am** at the HS stadium. We're looking forward to you joining us for this celebration.

Our students will then be participating in Field Day events and enjoying a school-wide lunch on the field. Please remember families are not included in these.

If the weather doesn't cooperate for Thursday, the rain date for these activities will be Friday, June 16th.

The Field Day event will include many different fun stations, including water stations. We will have a water bottle refill station and some tents for shade for the students.

Please help your child be prepared for the event by helping with the following -

- **Have your child wear to school** - bathing suit or water clothes, water shoes or shoes that can get wet, and hat (a field day t-shirt will be provided to wear as a cover-up)
- **Apply sunscreen at home** - to help reduce overexposure to the sun.
- **Pack for school** - a water bottle with your child's name on it, towel, and change of clothes (including underwear and shoes) to change into after

For the whole school community lunch, students can either bring a bagged lunch from home or purchase a bagged peanut butter and jelly lunch from school.

Please tear off and return the attached information sheet to help us plan for the event by June 9th. Thanks for helping prepare your child for this fun-filled day!

Please help us plan for the upcoming Field Day event and whole school community lunch by completing the following 2 sections and returning it to school with your child's teacher by Friday, June 9th.

 - I allow a directed adult to reapply with the **school provided** FDA approved sunscreen (Coppertone water resistant Broad Spectrum sunscreen lotion or spray).

✉ Letter from the Counselors

Hello DPS Families!

In May, Pre-K focused on keeping our hands to ourselves and asking before giving a hug or a high five. In accordance with Erin's Law, we read a book called "You Body Belongs to You", which focuses on saying no if you don't want to be touched, how you can still be friends with someone if you don't want a hug right now, and telling a trusted adult if someone touches your private parts. We

also listened to "[The Boundary Song](#)" and practiced saying, "No thank you." if you don't want to be touched or need some space.

Engage your child by asking:

- If you don't want a hug right now, what can you say? "No thank you", "Not right now please"
- If you don't want a hug from someone, can you still be friends? Yes

In kindergarten, we learned about the circle of control. We learned that we all face problems each day, and discussed the things that we can control versus those we cannot control. Even if something is out of our control, we can control how we react!

Engage your child by asking:

- What are some things that are in your control?
- What are some things that are not in your control?

In first grade, we focused on stranger safety and identifying safe adults in your child's life. We used the Safe Side curriculum (www.thesafeside.com). Students watched the video, then we had a discussion about who their safe adults are and what to do if a "don't know" tries to talk to them.

Engage your child by asking:

- Who are your safe side adults?
- What is a "don't know"? What is a "kinda know"?
- What should you do if a "don't know" wants you to go somewhere with them?
- If a person looks nice, are they safe to talk to?

In second grade, we learned about our emotional bank accounts. We learned that we can make a deposit into someone's emotional bank account by saying and doing kind things and can make a withdrawal from someone's emotional bank account by saying and doing things that are not kind. We did an experiment with apples and practiced giving our classmates compliments.

Engage your child by asking:

- What was the difference between the two apples?
- How can you make a deposit into someone's emotional bank account? Withdrawal?

Arrival

All **4PK-2nd grade students** will enter at the main entrance of school and must be to school by 8:00.

- Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8:10.
- Buses unload students at 7:40.



All 3PK students will enter at the side door at 9:00 for the AM program or 12:30 for the PM program.

Dismissal

Dismissal changes must be made **before 1:00pm**. Parent pick-up will begin at 2:20pm each day at the following doors based on last name. Please make sure we have the name of the person picking up and that person has a **driver's license for identification**.

- A-C at the ELC doorway on the parking lot side
- D-H at the back playground door
- I-Q at the first door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS
- R-Z at the second door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS

All 3PK AM and PM students will exit at the side door at 11:30 for the AM program and 3:00 for the PM program. Our 3PK students are dropped off and picked up in the small Primary Bus Loop during the following times: 8:45-9:00, 11:20-11:35, 12:20-12:30, and 2:50-3:05. Please consider parking in a different location so that you aren't trapped in the loop.

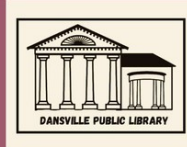

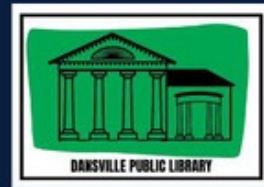
