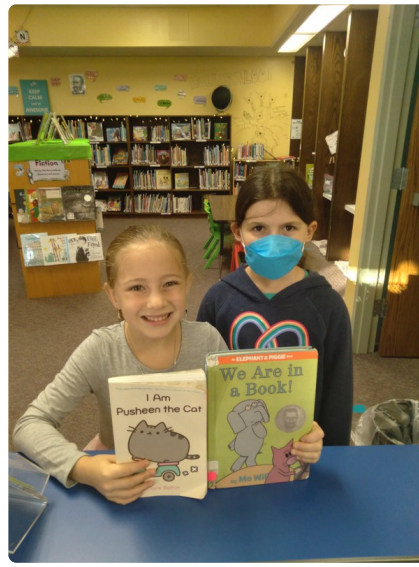

Letter From the Counselors

Hello DPS Families!

This week, we began pushing into each classroom to work on new skills. In Pre-K we learned about the different adults in the building. We heard all about how they help us in different ways and places throughout our school!

Engage your child by asking:

- At school, what is Miss Sarah's job? (cleaner or making sure our class is clean)
- What office does Mrs. Smith work in? (nurse's office)

In kindergarten through second grade, our focus was learning and practicing our listening skills. We discussed the four important parts of listening, including eyes watching the person who is speaking, ears listening to the person who is speaking, voice quiet when someone else is speaking, and having a calm body. Kindergarten read the book, "Listen, Buddy", First Grade read the book "Me First", and Second Grade had an interactive power point where they investigated why a classroom was missing the information their teacher was saying.

Engage your child by asking:

- What are the four listening skills we practiced?
 - Eyes watching
 - Ears listening
 - Voice quiet
 - Body calm
- Why is it important to listen?

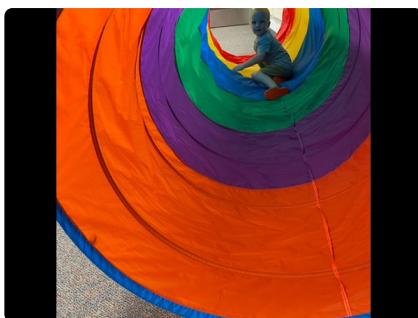

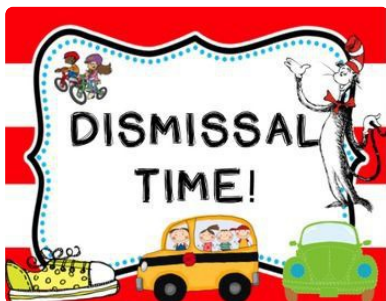
Arrival

All **4PK-2nd grade students** will enter at the main entrance of school and must be to school by 8:00.

- Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8:10.
- Buses unload students at 7:40.



All 3PK students will enter at the side door at 9:00 for the AM program or 12:30 for the PM program.



Dismissal

Dismissal changes must be made **before 1:00pm**.

Parent pick-up will begin at 2:20pm each day at the following doors based on last name. Please make sure we have the name of the person picking up and that person has a ***driver's license for identification***.

- A-C at the ELC doorway on the parking lot side
- D-H at the back playground door
- I-Q at the first door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS
- R-Z at the second door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS

All 3PK AM and PM students will exit at the side door at 11:30 for the AM program and 3:00 for the PM program.

- Sign in at the main office - you must present a driver's license to be scanned in our Raptor safety system
- Go right to cafeteria and after lunch sign right out at the office
- Do NOT take any pictures on your phone while at lunch



Review the bus rules

If your child currently rides a bus or will be riding a bus in the future, please be sure to review these important bus rules:

- Stay in seat with seatbelt fastened and tight
- Face forward with feet in front of you on the floor (not in the aisles)
- Follow directions from adults
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Use a Level 2 voice when talking
- Use kind words
- Patiently wait your turn when getting on and off the bus
