- Buses unload students at 7:40.



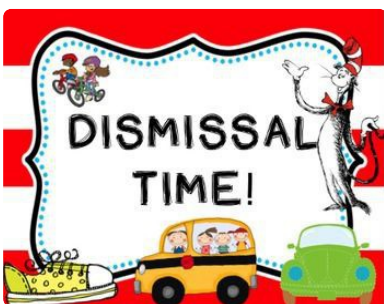
All 3PK students will enter at the side door at 9:00 for the AM program or 12:30 for the PM program.

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## Dansville Public Library Events


### September is Library Card Sign-up Month -
