Apply online at wichita.edu/apply. We'll need your completed application, a \$40 non-refundable application fee and transcripts from all colleges and universities you've attended. If you have questions regarding admissions requirements or your admissions status, please call the Office of Admissions at (316) 978-3085. For merit scholarship consideration, apply by Feb. 1.
