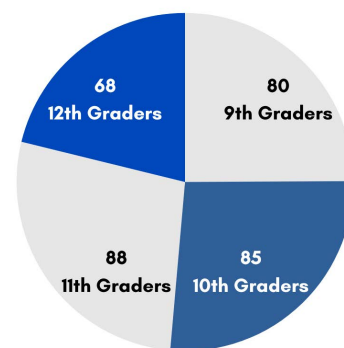
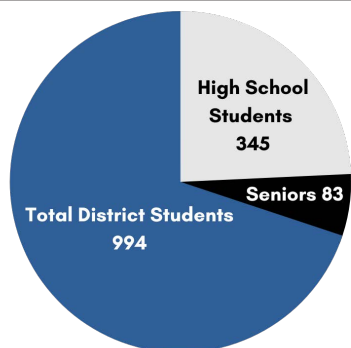

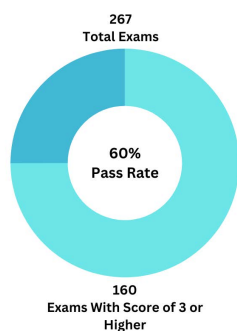
## Athletics

## 2020-2021 COVID Statement

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, BCS operated in an online format from March 16 – June 11, 2020. Content and Semester 2 grades were revised to be practicable under these circumstances. In 2020-2021, BCS operated in a hyflex educational model where students had the option of attending classes in person, online, or a combination of the two. Graduation requirements, course offerings, and our academic calendar continue to remain the same.
