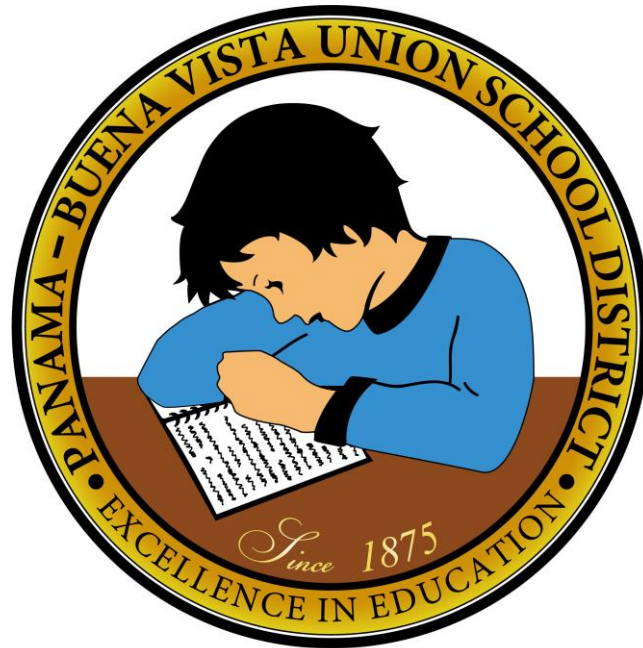

APPEAL PROCEDURES FOR DISQUALIFIED CONTRACTORS/PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

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PANAMA-BUENA VISTA UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT APPEAL PROCEDURE

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20101(d) every public agency that requires prospective bidders to prequalify must establish “a process that will allow prospective bidders to dispute their proposed prequalification rating prior to the closing time for receipt of bids.”

Annual Prequalification Appeal Procedure

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20101(d)(1) the Panama-Buena Vista Union School District will provide written notification of the basis for the prospective bidder’s disqualification “and any supporting evidence that has been received from others or adduced as a result of an investigation by the public entity.” The prospective bidder will have four (4) calendar days to appeal the disqualification. The District will make an appeal decision no later than ten (10) business days from the date of the appeal. The District will notify the prospective bidder of the appeal decision in writing.

Single Project Prequalification Procedure

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 20101(d)(1) the Panama- Buena Vista Union School District will provide written notification of the basis for the prospective bidder’s disqualification “and any supporting evidence that has been received from others or adduced as a result of an investigation by the public entity.” The prospective bidder will have four (4) calendar days to appeal the disqualification. The District will make an appeal decision no later than four (4) business days prior to the submission for bids for the single project. The District will notify the prospective bidder in writing of the decision.

Appeal Decisions

Appeal review and decisions have been delegated by the PBVUSD Board of Trustees to the Assistant /Associate Superintendent of Business Services or designee (hearing officer). Due to the District deadlines with regard to bidding and construction of public works projects, all appeal decisions by the hearing officer will be final and not subject to further consideration.
