Trip Details

Trip Details

Fly to Salt Lake City, Utah and then drive 3 hours to Idaho Falls, Idaho on Sunday, June 8

Complete training sessions on door-to-door faith conversations before attending this trip

Trip Details

Fly to Nashville, Tennessee, on Saturday, June 7. After arriving, you'll drive 20 minutes to Madison, TN, where Rock of Ages Lutheran Church is located. You'll start prepping materials for the science camp.
