Welcome Back! Attached please find the Andover Regional Assessment Information for the 2022-2023 school year. These assessments help collect data to develop targeted instructional practices and ensure our current curriculum meets our students' needs. This year, we will start with the New Jersey Start Strong Assessments. The assessments will take one class period each and will be administered without disrupting our regular class schedule.

Below you will find a key to explain the different columns in the attached table.

Key:

Number of Testing Administrations in Districts refers to the number of times a particular assessment will be offered during the school year.

Testing Mode refers to how the student will be administered the assessment. The two modes are computer-based and paper-and-pencil. Some computer-based assessments allow students to take the assessment using paper and pencil. Some children with medical issues may take paper and pencil tests if they are unable to take the assessment on the computer.

Testing Time is the maximum amount of time allotted to students to complete the assessment.

Testing Window is the period in which districts administer the statewide student assessment. It is not the actual number of days it takes a student to complete the assessment. NJSLA dates on the table are, however, listed as the actual dates.

Results Available refers to the dates districts receive individualized student results from the assessment vendor. These results are distributed to students, educators and families as soon as possible.
