What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	For participating providers: \$600/Covered Person or \$1,200/Family; For non-participating providers: \$600/Covered Person or \$1,200/Family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes. <a href="#">Preventive care</a> services, office visits and <a href="#">prescription drugs</a> purchased from a pharmacy are covered before you meet your deductible.
