Engagement in rich educational experiences off campus with a variety of field trips during a student's time at St. Patrick's. Starting with a trip to the farm in Kindergarten, to an all-day STEM experience in Annapolis for Grade 3, to the first overnight field trip in PA for Grade 4 and culminating with a multi-day Civil Rights trip in Grade 8 to Atlanta, Birmingham, and Montgomery, our students learn both on and off campus.
