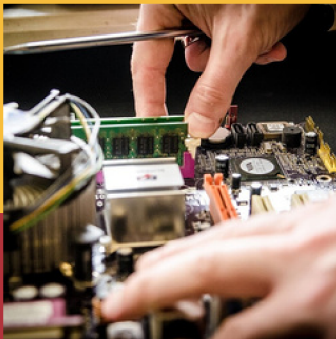


ICHS Career Tech Programs

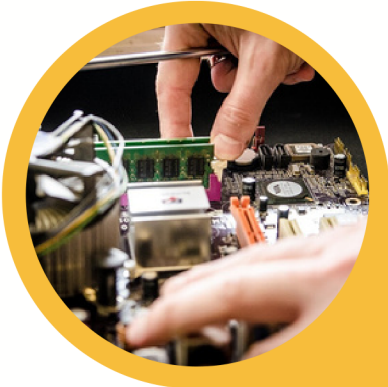

CAREER PATHWAYS @ ICHS

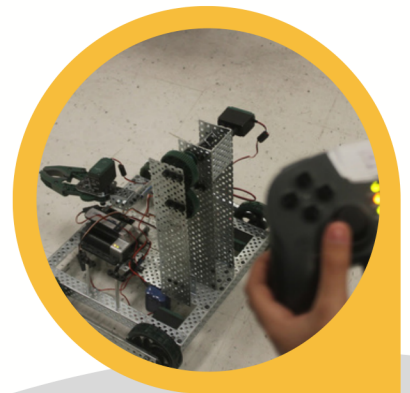
Interactive Media: Technical and professional level careers in the design, development and management of multimedia, web development, and media productions.

Natural Resources: Career-technical programs natural resource management, environmental services, agricultural and environmental education, communications and research.

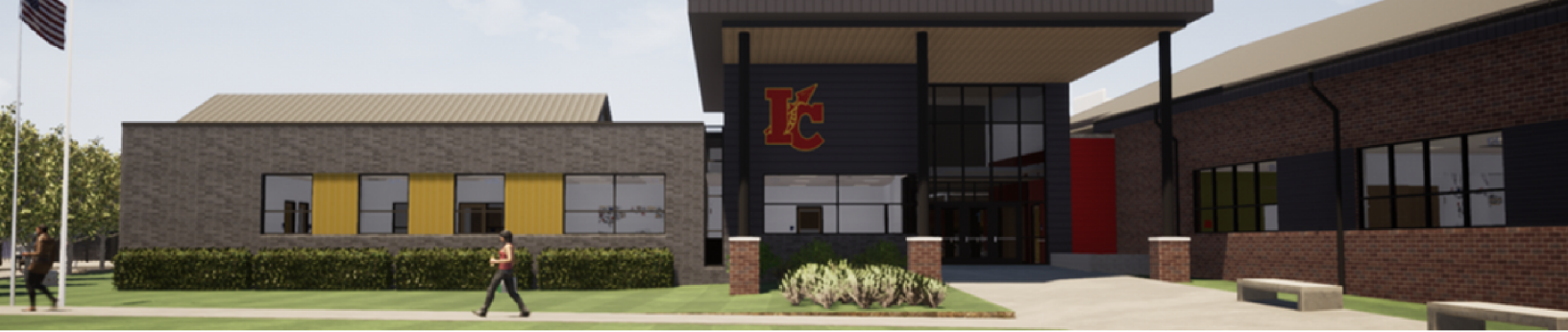


Business: Technical and professional level careers in business management, administrative support, human resources, business administration, legal management and medical management.

Family and Consumer Sciences (FCS) is a set of courses that draws from a range of disciplines and contexts (education, business, social, economic, cultural, technological, geographical, political) to achieve optimal and sustainable living for individuals, families and communities.

Career Base Intervention (CBI)

Career-Based Intervention (CBI) is a career-tech program for Grade 9-12, students who are ages 15-21 and identified as disadvantaged (academically, economically or both) and having barriers to achieving academic and career success. The program is designed to help students improve academic competency, develop professional skills and implement a career plan that will serve them on the path to graduation and beyond.
