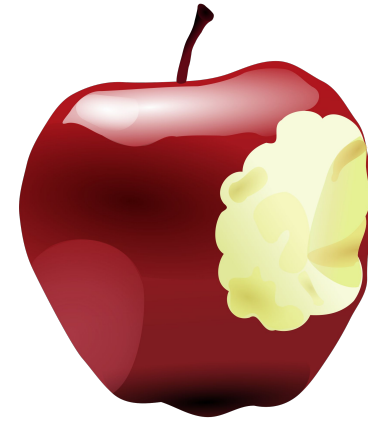

FOOD POLICY

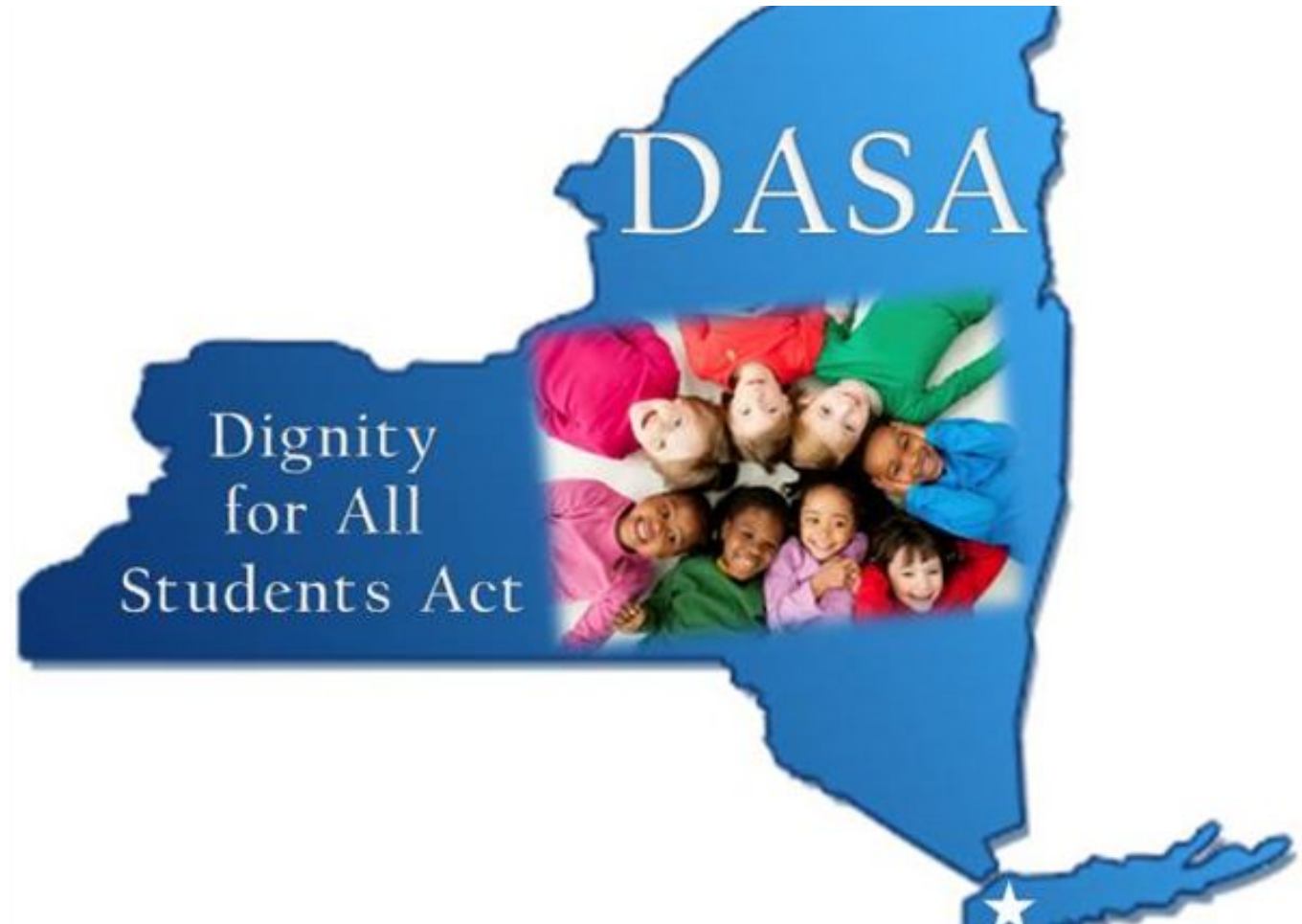
